

Socialist-Labor Candidate Claims Roosevelt, Landon Both Capitalists' Minions

John W. Alken, candidate for president of the United States on the socialist-labor ticket, told a handful of people at Seventh and Pine streets last night that Roosevelt and Landon represent the same thing, and that the solution of America's ill lies in

Industrial unionism as favored by the socialist-labor party. Alken denied that the new deal is socialistic and that Mr. Roosevelt is a collectivist. The new deal, he said, is merely an expedient offered in an attempt to save capitalism. He charged that the "most invidious and dangerous tendency in the last decade and especially under Roosevelt has been the trend toward government control and monopoly."

Industrial Union Government. At the same time, the handsome young candidate, who has an accent that hints strongly of Harvard, struck out at those who "prate so passionately about liberty in abstraction but will have none of it in concrete for the masses." He said that those who sing the praises of "rugged individualism," and profess great reverence for the constitution are by

no means to be considered as a bulwark against reaction. Alken, citing the destiny which his party hoped for America, said that the "unions will be the basis of an industrial union government which will place the class-dominated political state. The socialist-labor party will cease to exist the day the industrial unions take over the reins of government." The speaker said his party aims for a non-violent revolution. He cracked solidly at Earl Browder, the communist candidate, who, he said, had in reality urged the re-election of Roosevelt in his plea that Landon must be defeated at all costs. Alken, youngest candidate for the office, came in from Bend. After the visit here he will speed to San Francisco. He is on a 10,000-mile tour of the country. H. Simon is accompanying Alken on the trip.

Various officials and departments of the Klamath county court house are casting envious eyes upon the suite now occupied by the health unit, but which will be vacated September 1, when the unit moves into its new quarters at Seventh and Pine streets.

Those who have put in bids to the county court for the suite include the district attorney, the county school superintendent, county juvenile officers and the Klamath Bar association, which

desires to use the room for a law library.

Although Judge Grizzle has declined to make any announcement as to disposal of the rooms, it is rumored about the court house that the law library is to be moved into the large room of the unit offices, and that the smaller room will be used by the district attorney and the bar association.

With the removal of the county law library, its present quarters will probably be turned over to the juvenile department, according to court house gossip.
