PALMYRA, Mo., (AP) — T. E. Pratt, retired railroad employee, has opened a "loafing office" as a place to meet and talk with his friends.

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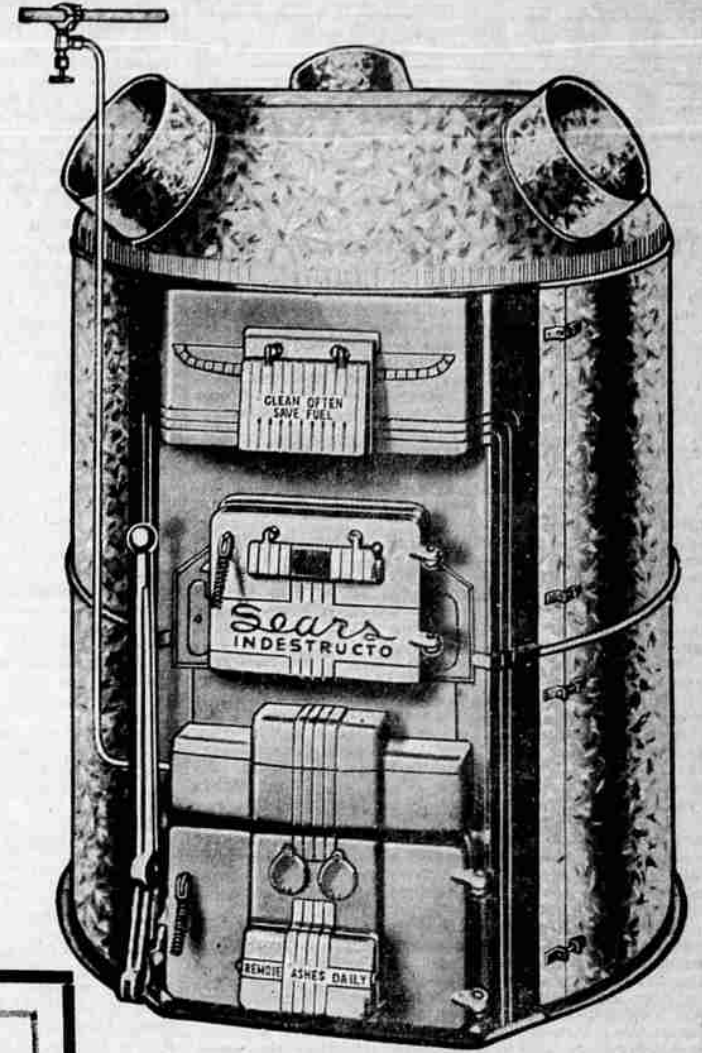
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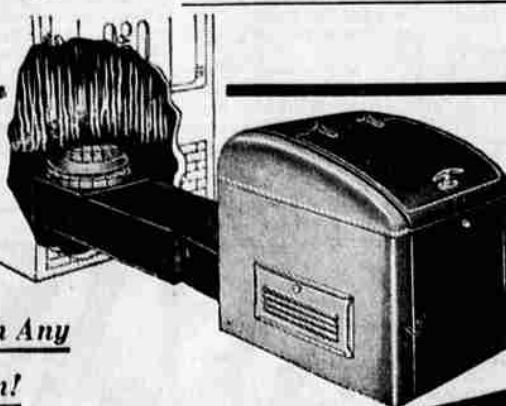
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
