

**Dies Witness Tells of Plans For Soviet Ship**

WASHINGTON, Sept. 21 (AP)—Joseph Dalinda, dealer in patents for munitions products, told the Dies inquiry yesterday he had ex-

pected to get \$150,000 in soviet money for his part in a deal for the building in America of a large battleship for Russia. At the same time, the Russian-born promoter said his interest was "not entirely financial." The battleship project fol-

lowed when Russia rejected the plans, but Dalinda got \$20,500, he said, for his part in bringing together a soviet agent and alleged "contact" men who were to aid in getting state department approval of the ship plans. News and Herald Want-Ads got results.

**GERMANS HISSED IN NAZI PICTURE**

LONDON, Sept. 21 (AP)—The film "I Was a Captive in Nazi Germany," playing at the Oxford street cinema, is drawing ap-

plause and hisses at every performance. The film is based on the experiences of Miss Isobel Steele, young American arrested in Berlin in 1934 on suspicion of espionage. She was kept in a German prison and eventually allowed to return to the United States after Sen.

William E. Borah had intervened. Miss Steele plays the principal role. All other actors are anonymous. Public demonstrations occur at every performance. The hisses are for Adolf Hitler and Paul Joseph Goebbels and the cheers, for Borah.
