

**SURFACING WORK ON WILLAMETTE ROAD PROGRESSES**

**CASCADE SUMMIT**—Warren Northwest Construction company has been surfacing the Willamette highway near here. Heated asphalt has been poured over

crushed rock and screenings, then covered with screenings, watered and rolled. It has been reported that cars will be able to pass over the highway this fall, although it will not be kept open this winter.

Bennett & Taylor unloaded a diesel powered shovel at Cascade Summit to be used to grade the last stretch of the highway near

Salt Creek Falls. The shovel weighed 90,000 pounds and cost \$22,000.

Last Sunday while asphalt, heated to 412 degrees, was being hauled to the highway it exploded, blowing the top off the tank. The driver leaped from the truck and received only minor injuries. The truck which had just been started and was mov-

ing slowly, came to a stop a few feet from the disaster. Asphalt was poured along the road.

The use of "anti-stall" slots permanently cut in the leading edge of the wings have been found to completely eliminate wing-tip stalls, and permit positive lateral control well below the normal stalling point.
