

# STUDENT BODY WILL PRESENT ANNUAL PLAY

A veteran cast of actors will pass before the spotlight in the KUHS auditorium Thursday night when the high school student body presents James Reach's "One Mad Night" as its annual performance.

The play describes the experiences of a playwright who rented what was supposed to be a lonely and deserted mansion in which he hoped to be able to write a play in peace and quiet. The mansion, which turns out to be filled with a number of very eccentric people, is anything but the peaceful and quiet place he had hoped for, and it is in this setting the "one

## WARMER WEATHER REPORTED HERE

Temperatures throughout the Klamath basin were reported warmer Wednesday as the flurry of a light snow storm during the night whitened the ground and surrounding hills. A minimum temperature was reported at 31 degrees. Maximum Tuesday was 34 degrees and at 2 o'clock Wednesday the maximum on an unofficial thermometer was 43 degrees.

Precipitation from 5 p. m. Tuesday to 8 a. m. Wednesday was checked as a "trace" by the US weatherman. Total precipitation for the stream year is 4.54 inches as compared to normal which is 3.42. Last year at this date precipitation was 3.30 inches. Forecast for Thursday was probably rain with no change in temperature.
