

KLAMATH WILL HAVE BRANCH IN EDUCATION

Residents of Klamath Falls and vicinity who are anxious to study particular problems in psychology and get regular college or university credit at the same time will have this opportunity when the "Klamath Falls branch" of the Oregon state system of higher education opens its winter term Thursday, January 4, in Fremont school.

The courses, "Genetic Psychology" and "Social Psychology," meet for two-hour periods. The instructor will be L. E. Messenger, assistant professor of psychology from Southern Oregon College of Education.

The genetic psychology class will meet each Thursday afternoon at 4:15 o'clock. It will take up the growth of behavior during the prenatal period, infancy, and early childhood. Also to be studied will be facts and theories pertaining to the development of locomotion, perception, emotion, intelligence, language, and social behavior in the young child.

The social psychology group will meet each Thursday evening at 7:15. Topics to be discussed are psychological processes involved in social communication, transmission of custom, social change, social cooperation and interdependence, group conflict, public opinion, social control of the individual, crowd behavior, and leadership.

These courses are planned to serve all who show sufficient maturity and background to carry on the work profitably to themselves. Registration should be made at the first meeting of classes. Additional information may be obtained by writing General Extension Division, University of Oregon, Eugene.

COMMISSION TO AID SMALL GAME

A new project recently inaugurated by the state game commission through aid of Pittman-Robertson federal funds provides for the development of seed in the Willamette valley for the benefit of pheasants, quail and other small game.

Sites of not less than 1000 acres each that are suitable for restocking purposes will be selected and easement control for a period of five years secured from the landowners, which will give the commission the right to develop food and cover resources on the land, restock it with game and regulate the seasons and methods of hunting.

The program proposes to keep the refuge closed to all hunting for a period of three years, after which they will be opened on a rotation basis. It is anticipated that this plan, together with last year's closure of the Willamette valley, will accomplish a great deal toward the rehabilitation of the pheasant and small game in the western part of Oregon.

Inasmuch as a detailed survey of game conditions had previously been made in Benton county by the Oregon research unit, the present program is being initiated in that county to take advantage of the data already available but will be extended to other counties of the valley also.

Although the work has been under way for only a short period, farmers and landowners have shown a great interest in the program and in most cases have cooperated readily in signing up the necessary easements.
