RALLY STEMS STOCK MARKET SELLING WAVE

NEW YORK, Jan. 15 (AP)—Rallying wheat and a less than expected drop in this week's steel mill operations helped stem a stock market selling drive today but failed to promote any substantial upward reversal.
The list tried for a mild comeback at the start without attracting many bullish customers. There was a quick shift to the downside and, with the turnover fairly heavy in the fourth hour, losses ran to 3 or more points for leaders.

When the official steel estimate came out, placing output at 4.8 per cent of capacity, off 1.3 points from the week before, offerings dried up appreciably and extreme declines were reduced at the close. The majority of forecasts were for a decrease in steel output of about 4 points.
