FEW GAINS ON MARKET LIST AS DAY ENDS

NEW YORK, Jan. 23 (P)—Stocks wavered in today's final market hour when commodities tumbled but last-minute support enabled an assortment of aviation, steel and specialties to finish with gains of fractions to a point or so.

The list put on a mild rally after a mixed start and moderate advances were well distributed during the greater part of the day. Despite the show of firmness at the close, many issues remained behind minus signs. U. S. Steel and Bethlehem jumped up just before the sound of the concluding gong. Transfers were small throughout, although the turnover topped 500,000 shares.

Business news was colorless generally and forenoon buying was attributed mainly to speculative nibbling on the theory that offerings in the past several sessions might indicate the bottom was not far away.

WHEAT SLUMPS ON LIQUIDATION WAVE

CHICAGO, Jan. 23 (P)—After a steady to easier start the wheat market weakened today under liquidation pressure and at times lost as much as 1/4 cents a bushel.

Some stop-loss selling entered the market as May fell below the dollar mark, occasional support was attributed to shorts, but buying interest generally was light.

May contracts fell to 99 3/4c, down 1 1/2 cents, and July to 96 3/4c, down 1 1/2 cents.

Wheat closed 1-1/2c lower, May 99 3/4c, July 96 3/4c; corn 1-1/2c down, May and July 57 1/4c; oats 1/2-3/4c down.
