

ATTENDANCE ON INCREASE FOR RAYBURN TALKS

The union meetings at the First Presbyterian church under the leadership of Dr. James Rayburn are now well under way and many are coming to hear him from all over the Klamath basin. Every night a large delegation comes from Merrill where he held unusually successful meetings in 1937, following the campaign in Klamath Falls. His addresses this time are for Christian people, for the deepening of the spiritual life, and the strengthening of the church. He approaches the work of the church with a viewpoint entirely different from that of the average evangelist.

The audiences have been steadily growing and the capacity of the church will be taxed to the limit by the end of the week. In case of need a loud speaker is being arranged for, so that an overflow can be had in the basement of the church. Thus far Dr. Rayburn has agreed to remain for the week only, but there is an insistent demand that, if possible, he continue longer.

Last night Dr. Rayburn spoke on a text which he "wished had not needed to be put in the Bible, a tragic statement. 'No man cared for my soul.'" This text comes from the Old Testament, but he connected with it one from the New Testament, which reads, "For I have no man like-minded, who will care

truly for your state. For they seek their own, not the things of Jesus Christ."

He said in part: "What is it to care for souls? 'First, it is to have a real definite knowledge of their value. We live in a materialistic age, wherein we measure men in the money market. Christ saw values in human hearts."

"What is it to care for souls? It is to have a tender solicitude for their welfare."

"What is it to care for souls? It is to feel an alarming apprehension of their dangers. Men speak of God's love, but men care nothing for the love of God, so God gives us warnings. A sermon on hell, if it is preached in the right spirit, is just as full of the love of God as a sermon on heaven. It is a terrible thing for the sinner to know, as the Bible states. 'The wrath of God abideth on him.' I have wondered as I have walked the streets of great cities, why God didn't strike off some things from the face of the earth. I met a man who was a faro gambler who said to me, 'I just got out of San Francisco. It is getting so rotten something is going to happen.' Within two months the earthquake came. Every day that a man goes without God, he is piling up wrath against himself."

"Now, who should care for souls? First of all parents should care. I was talking to some preachers who said, 'Our greatest problem is with parents from 25 to 45 years of age. They care not for their children.' Teachers in the Sunday school should care. Ministers should care. I never allow any one to talk to me about my profession. I have a calling. I remember a minister, years ago, saying to me, 'I visit the sick professionally.' He had better stay away from the sick. The

members of the church should be concerned and be soul-winners. I never saw a bridge-winner that was a soul-winner. A man living close to Christ ought to win at least one soul to God every year. If every member were to do that, it would not take longer than one generation to win the world to Christ. A church of 17 in Tulsa, Oklahoma, inside of 12 years grew to 1000, because a little group of men went out every Tuesday to save souls."

At 2:30 o'clock every day, Dr. Rayburn gives a new exposition of the book of Revelation, thrilling in its sanity and helpfulness. At 7:45 Dr. Rayburn speaks every evening. Wednesday night's subject was to be "Demas."

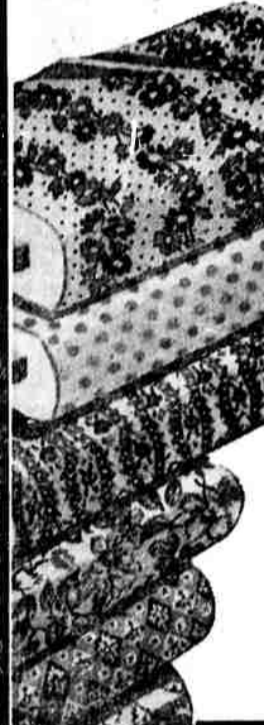
