

BLOOD OFFERED TO SAVE SUFFERERS OF RARE DISEASE

OAKLAND, Calif., March 21 (UP)—Mrs. Margaret Putnam,

daughter of Congressman Frank H. Buck, today offered her blood to two victims of the rare blood disease from which she recovered two years ago—staphylococcus septicemia. She submitted to a laboratory

test and her blood, type four, was found suitable for use in at least one of the cases, that of 12-year-old Sheldon Bellafsky of Chicago. The other victim is A. E. Robinson, 52, of Phoenix, Ariz. Other donors were being

sought because the transfusions require daily administration. Two others who had survived the disease were located and may be used: Eugene Withers, sailor on the USS Breeze, due at Mare Island navy yard, and Alfred G. Sutton of Inglewood.

FIREMAN ENTERS INNOCENT PLEA IN TRIANGLE DEATH

TACOMA, Wash., March 21 (UP)—John Ord, 46, city fire-

man, pleaded innocent in superior court today to the first-degree murder of Mrs. Myra Ord Nosler, who left him after 10 years to marry another man. Mrs. Nosler was shot and her husband of a day, Hale Nosler, shot and turned into a human
