

MAN BOUND OVER ON THEFT CHARGE

Jerry Paul Erdman, charged with larceny in a dwelling, was arraigned before Justice of the Peace J. A. Mahoney Tuesday and was bound over to the grand jury after waiving preliminary hearing. Bond was set at \$1000 cash or \$2500 property and Erdman was committed to the county jail.

Erdman was arrested in connection with the alleged rifling of two cabins in the Rocky Point district owned by Grant Fouch and Paul Wampler.

PHOTOGRAPHER GETS PICTURE OF TRAIN, BUT DIES ON JOB

SUISUN, Calif., March 21 (UP)—Thomas Dardin, 23, amateur photographer, got his picture Wednesday but lost his life when struck by the streamline train, City of San Francisco.

The film in his camera was developed and printed. He obtained an excellent picture of the train that killed him.

Dardin, a Southern Pacific employe, stood just off the tracks to photograph the limited train as it raced through the Suisun station. He snapped the shutter and jumped back, but slipped over a cement curb and the train brushed him out of the way.

He got the camera only a

week ago and had once before tried to photograph the train without good results.

Dardin is a nephew of Ansel S. Williams, superintendent of Stockton city schools.

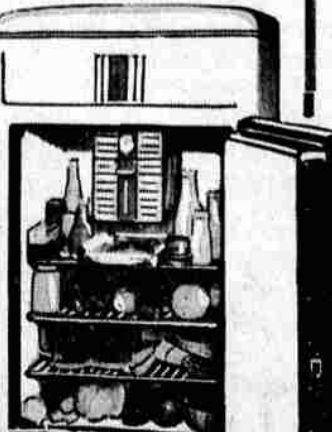
