## New Placements Show Trend Toward Private Industry

The trend back to private employment that received such impetus in Oregon last year is even more pronounced in 1940. Figures from 21 state employment offices for the first three months of 1940 show a 51 per cent increase in private placements, while new public jobs dropped off nearly 55 per cent. Of the 10,906 placements reported to Director L. C. Stoll since the first of the year, 8896 were for private industry, and 2010 for public work. Last year the comparable figures were 5883 private and 4428 public jobs. Here are the placements by months this year: March 4380; February 2637; January 3869.

Although second to Portland in total placements, Klamath Falls made the best record
