NEW YORK, April 22 (AP) — Stock market buying mainly was in specialties today, most leaders encountering difficulties in extending Saturday's rally. Aircrafts and steels stepped out in the forenoon. They found the going a bit rough and the majority eventually subsided. Early selling was absorbed fairly well, however, and gains of fractions to more than a point predominated after midday. The pace slowed appreciably in the latter part of the proceedings and prices were no better than steady at the close. Transfers approximated 900,000 shares. Touching new highs for the year—some eventually backed down—were Allied Mills, Celanese, Armour, Wilson & Co., International Paper preferred, American Bosch and Bush Terminal.
