

PERSHING ISSUES RED CROSS PLEA

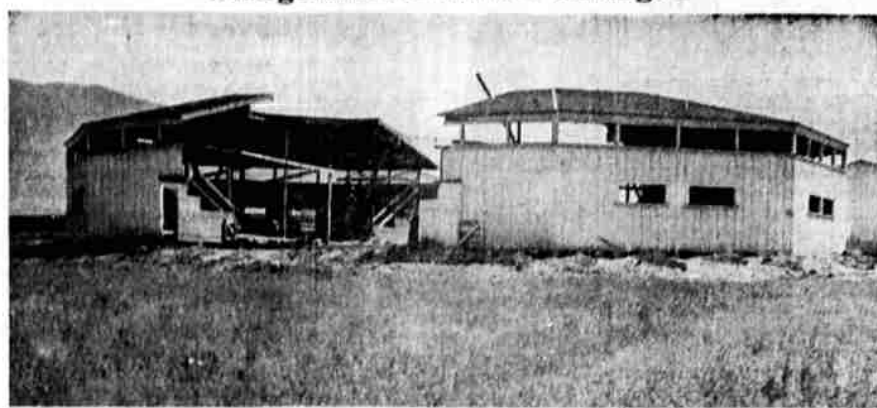
Earl B. Redman, chairman of the Klamath county chapter of the American Red Cross, has received a communication from Norman H. Davis, national chairman, containing a statement from General John J. Pershing, commander of this country's expeditionary forces during the first World war.

General Pershing's statement in full, follows:

"It is with sadness the peace-loving people of this nation witness another war in Europe. Only two decades ago, thousands of our best men gave their lives in the hope that the world never resort to war again. In the subsequent years the United States has done all in its power to make peace prevail. The ever-lengthening trail of suffering and misery which invading armies are now leaving behind them in Europe has blasted all our hopes.

"There is one thing which all Americans can now do, and that is to unite to alleviate the horrors of war for the civilian in

the stricken nations. This we can do through the American Red Cross which is now appealing to the nation for a war-relief fund of at least \$10,000,000.
