

## COMMENDATION OF LOCAL RED CROSS GIVEN

Commendation of the Red Cross war relief effort is given by J. W. Kerns, prominent Klamath business man, in a letter to the Red Cross office. His letter follows.

"It has come to my attention that the Red Cross is making a drive for funds for war relief in Europe.

"I believe this to be a very worthy cause due to the enormous number of refugees in the battle area who are undoubtedly in dire need. If some agency does not take an active part in providing them with the necessities of life, a large number

of them will die from starvation, and this necessity will grow as the winter months come on.

"As this work will require a considerable length of time, I believe the American people should respond wholeheartedly to the Red Cross call for assistance in this emergency. It seems to me that the Red Cross has the best set up for handling such work and will be able to apply the greatest part of the money raised directly to the work necessary.

"You will find enclosed my check for \$20 as a contribution to this fund.

From March 4, 1861, until the death of John Tyler, Jan. 18, 1862, there were five living ex-presidents of the United States.

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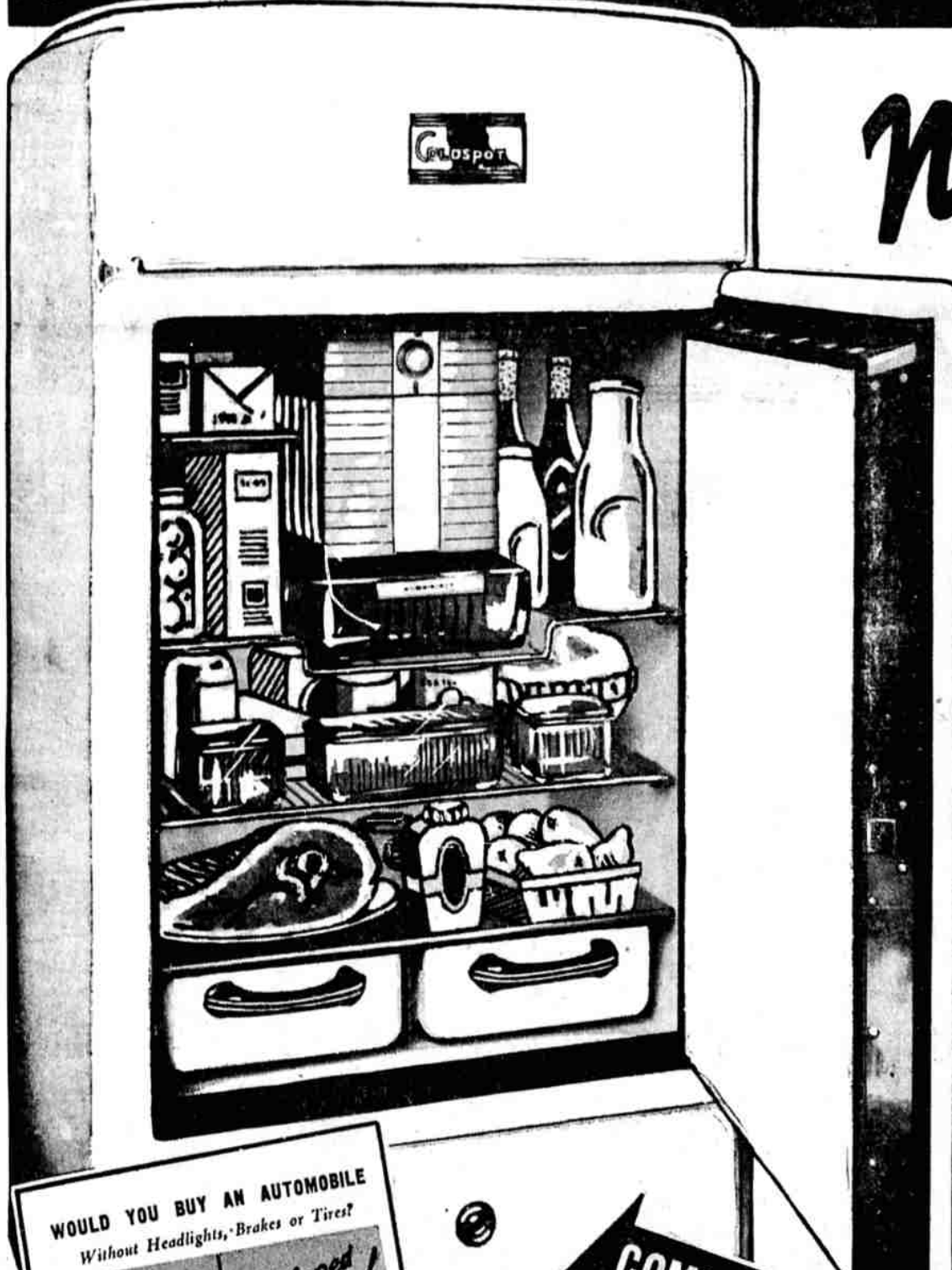
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
