CHAMBER DISCUSSES TOURISTS, NEW ROAD

Plans for getting the Weed tourist information office into operation for the summer season and for participation with Roseburg and Douglas county in the celebration at Diamond lake on Friday of the completion of grading of the North Umpqua highway from Roseburg to the lake occupied the attention of the directors of the Klamath county chamber of commerce at their meeting on Wednesday.

A caravan is coming from Douglas county and will be met at the south end of Diamond lake by representatives from the Basin area. A program, in which Klamath county will participate will be held, beginning about 1:30 Friday afternoon. Tables for a picnic lunch will be provided and coffee will be served by representatives of the forest service. All residents of the Basin area who can make the trip to Diamond lake Friday are urged by the chamber to do so.

The tourist information office maintained by the chamber each summer at Weed will be continued this year. Its purpose is to provide information regarding this area and the inter-mountain country to the north. Klamath county and various districts in Oregon and Washington participate in the cost.

At the suggestion of the Roseburg chamber of commerce, the directors approved a resolution to be sent to Oregon's representatives in Washington urging congress to remain in session until the present national crisis passes.

It was announced by Secretary Reynolds of the chamber that for the current construction season state highway contracts totaling approximately a million dollars will be under way in the Klamath area.

WORD RECEIVED FROM DELEGATES TO HI-Y MEET

ASHLAND, June 20 — Technical supervisors to work in conjunction with production heads for the annual Shakespearean productions here this year have been named by Director William David Cottrell.

Richard Farmer and Delmar Solem, of Hollywood and Tracy, Minn., respectively, have been selected as technical directors, succeeding Robert Stedman who is attending summer school but plans to join the group in July. Solem arrived in Ashland this week after a hitch-hiking jaunt from half way across the nation.

Kent Robbins, Ashland, will be stage manager while Richard Putney will undertake the electrical duties. Francis Schilling and Jean Grantham of Medford, are serving as book-holders. Miss Schilling has worked in this capacity for the past four years and is familiar with all phases of the play.

Modern adaption of "Much Ado About Nothing" has been undertaken by Dorothy Pruitt, a veteran Shakespearean actress who has assumed the assistant directors job. She has been a member of the Festival group for the past five years and is well known throughout southern Oregon for her excellent dramatic work.

Original music is being composed by John Reisacher, another veteran actor who has appeared in a number of community dramas and is holding several leading roles in the current plays.

LeMerle Beck, embarking upon her second season with the group, will supervise dances and participate in the productions. She holds major roles in "The Comedy of Errors" and "As You Like It."
