NEW YORK, July 8 (AP)—The stock market hunted unsuccessfully for a trend today as traders were unable to uncover any real inspiration in either the domestic or foreign news.

Dealings and price changes were inconsequential throughout and at the close slight gains and losses were fairly well balanced. Transfers for the five hours were in the neighborhood of 250,000 shares, one of the smallest turnovers for a full session in 18 years.
