

S. P. EMPLOYE IN RACE FOR ASSEMBLYMAN

William I. Gunlock, a Southern Pacific employe living at Dunsmuir, has announced his candidacy for the democratic nomination for assemblyman for the district comprising Siskiyou, Shasta, Modoc, Plumas, Lassen, Sierra and Trinity counties in California. The California primary is set for August 27.

Gunlock is a member of the Brotherhood of Locomotive Firemen and Enginemen. He is a World war veteran, having served overseas with the US navy and is a member of the Dunsmuir post of the American Legion. He is a member of the Dunsmuir aerie of the Eagles.

The candidate served as chairman of the Siskiyou county democratic central committee in 1938-39, resigning to become census supervisor for the eight northern California counties.

He points out in his behalf that he knows legislative procedure, having served the legislature as engrossing and enrolling clerk from 1929 to 1939, inclusive.

RAILROAD NEWS

Appointment of M. W. Ehmke, assistant general freight agent for Southern Pacific company, with headquarters in Portland, was announced by H. W. Klein, general freight agent, to become effective August 1. Ehmke succeeds W. H. Francis, who is being promoted to general freight agent for Southern Pacific at El Paso.

Ehmke, whose service with Southern Pacific began in 1917 on the Salt Lake division, was for many years in the traffic department at Fresno. In 1934 he was transferred to the company's general freight department in San Francisco, later becoming head of the transcontinental freight rate bureau.

OFFICERS DISCUSS NATIONAL DEFENSE

About a dozen Klamath peace officers attended a conference on national defense held by the federal bureau of investigation at Medford Wednesday. The meeting was called by J. D. Swenson, special agent in charge of the FBI in Portland.

What is expected of local officers in a coordinated national defense plan was the main topic of the discussions. Sabotage, espionage and subversive activities were touched upon.

FIREMAN HURT IN ABERNATHY MISHAP DIES

CASCADE SUMMIT — Keith Kendall, fireman on one of the ill-fated helper engines which left the track near Abernathy, five miles north of Cascade Summit, died at Eugene hospital Tuesday afternoon from burns received in the wreck. He leaves a wife and small daughter. Kendall was a young man who went to work for the Southern Pacific in 1936 as fireman. F. L. Weichlein, Eugene, engineer, and George H. Kann, Eugene, fireman, who were also injured, have now recovered.

Glenn Eddings, engineer on the second engine which derailed but did not overturn, received only minor injuries.

John Virnig, water service man for the Southern Pacific company at Cascade Summit, whose district extends to McCredie Springs and who rides the engines to the different points on his district each day, owes his escape to his breaking a long established habit of riding the first engine. Without any particular reason he that morning rode the second engine.

The cause of the wreck is as yet undetermined. General Manager McDonald and his assistant, A. B. Wilson, were at the place of the wreck. Portland division officials were also there to get information which might determine what caused the two engines to leave the track without apparent reason. Two section crews under supervision of Guy Weaver and Gene Lavoy were working near the scene at the time of the accident.
