

YOUTHS SOUGHT FOR TRAINING IN NATIONAL DEFENSE

The Oregon state employment service has been delegated to contact the boys who are interested in the national defense training program, now under the

supervision of the state board for vocational education. The standards for selection have been established by the industries, and specify among other things, that a boy must be 18 years of age, an American citizen, which must be attested to by a birth certificate, and he must be a high school graduate, with at least

two years of industrial arts shop work, and have two or more years of mechanical drawing. One year of plane geometry and unified mathematics are looked upon as definite assets. Those boys who have had these prerequisites in high schools having an enlarged curriculum, with the academic stud-

ies balanced with vocational training in industrial arts and related courses in mechanical drawing, are now getting the "breaks" in qualifying for the training under the industrial defense program. With some few exceptions, the high schools over the state are adding to their program of vo-

national training as part of their regular curriculum. No offense to any, but respect from all, should be the motive of the united All-American trade bloc.—Edward L. Noble, undersecretary of commerce, to the National Foreign Trade Convention.
