

NEW 'VACUUM CLEANER' USED ON CLOVER SEED

Definitely pleased with the performance of a "vacuum cleaner" designed to pick up strawberry clover seed, J. C. "Jim" Stevenson, Tulelake potato grower and farmer, was watching the machine operate at the Gene Hammond ranch near Merrill this week.

Stevenson designed the machine and Hammond assisted him in the financial construction. The model now operating at the latter's place was built and assembled by the O. J. Harris machine shop in Merrill.

The machine is designed primarily for work among the small seed crops, Stevenson said. It operates from the rear of an Allis-Chalmers harvester, cuts a swath five feet wide and eight inches deep and works "100 per cent" according to the designer. The machine was first put to a test on the Hammond's place and now at the Stevenson ranch where it is working on 50 acres of strawberry clover.

Stevenson stated he had applied for a U. S. patent and it is hoped to be available for other farmers within another year's time. Probable cost of the machine was in the neighborhood of \$500. It was learned from Stevenson.

NEW SECTION OF PACIFIC HIGHWAY NEARLY COMPLETE

The new section of road on the Pacific highway, U. S. 99, across the Siskiyou mountains between Hornbrook and Ashland is now 90 per cent complete and in use, reports the touring bureau of the Oregon State Motor association. WPA LABORERS PENALIZED FOR HEARING WILLIE

SCHENECTADY, N. Y., Oct. 23 (AP)—Thirty-nine WPA laborers were penalized Tuesday for leaving their jobs "without permission" to hear Wendell L. Willkie speak here Oct. 14. Schenectady County WPA Supervisor Denis C. Dempsey said.

The men lost one-half hour's pay each and were suspended for two days, Dempsey asserted. They were working on projects near Union station where the republican presidential nominee spoke.

CHRISTMAS TREE DEALERS WARNED

MOUNT SHASTA, Calif.—Recently it was pointed out that Christmas tree dealers were not complying with the California law (Sec. 384a, Penal Code) requiring notarized permits for

trees in transport or possession. Many complaints have been registered by legitimate dealers who must compete with stolen trees on the market. Land owners who have been robbed of their trees and public spirited citizens are demanding that trespass upon Christmas tree lands be stopped. Law enforcement officers believe that considerable abuse of this law has occurred in the past and as shown by the fact that many legitimate tree dealers could not show legal possession of their trees when asked. This situation has made it a very difficult problem to determine just who is the trespasser and who is the legitimate or authorized party. Trees from other states pour across the border, and it is reported that few have the proper authentic papers required by law.

Local, county, state and federal officers have therefore adopted a policy of rigid enforcement of the state law. In order to avoid any favoritism the law will apply to trees coming from other states as well as from within California.

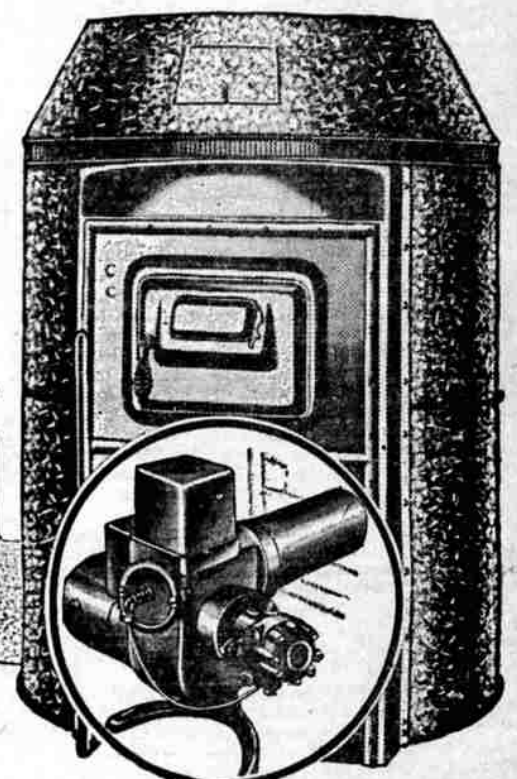

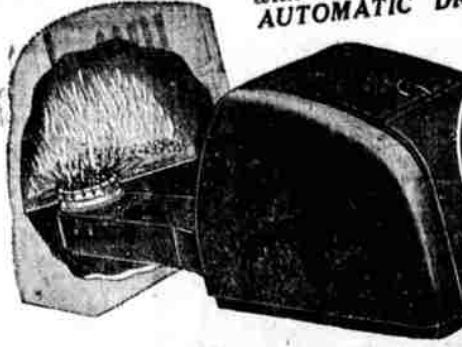
