

Oysters "R" in Season, So Take These New Hints



Creamy oyster stew is ideal for fall luncheon.

Now that oysters are in season from coast to coast the controversy arises—how do you make an oyster stew? There are many answers, most of them delicious. With Friday's hot lunch or dinner in mind, let's take a look at some of the recipes for oyster stew to the American taste.

Metropolitan Stew (Serves 4)

Two dozen medium oysters, 4 cups rich milk, 4 tablespoons butter, 4 teaspoons worcestershire sauce, celery salt, salt, pepper and paprika.

Drain oysters. Save the liquor. Heat 2 tablespoons butter in a large saucepan. Add drained oysters. Cook until edges begin to curl. Then add oyster liquor, heat and add all the milk. Season with celery salt, salt, pepper and paprika. Bring to boiling point rapidly. In bowls, place remaining butter. Just before pouring stew into bowls, add worcestershire sauce. Stir and pour. Sprinkle more paprika on top of each serving.

Blue Point Stew
One pint oysters, 4 tablespoons butter, 2 to 4 cups rich milk, or 3 cups milk and 1 cup light cream, scalded; salt and paprika. Sauté oysters in butter until edges curl. Add to hot milk, season with salt and paprika, and serve at once.

DINNER: Tomato juice, fish steaks baked in vegetable stock, scalloped potatoes, green beans, orange gelatin whip, frosted cup cakes, coffee, milk.

freshly ground black pepper, 11 teaspoons paprika.

DRAIN OYSTERS. Heat butter in saucepan. Add drained oysters. Cook until edges curl. Add milk and seasoning. Bring to just below the boiling point and serve at once.
