MERRILL—In observance of National Book week, November 10-16, Merrill Women of the Moose are participating with recognition by the library committee under the chairmanship of Mrs. Beedina Reeder.

Franklin K. Mathews, chief librarian of the Boy Scouts of America, is responsible for the idea of book week. Mr. Mathews interested fellow librarians in the idea of devoting a seven-day period to stressing books for boys and the idea met with immediate success with books for girls also being included and the week became Children's Book week.

Enthusiasm and interest in the idea mounted and the influence of the movement widened until its original juvenile significance reached out and included children and adults as the program was yearly promoted and advanced by the American Library association, together with numerous civic organizations. The Women of the Moose adopted their library program in 1930.

The organization constantly strives to lead mankind to the world of books through their efforts to build an adequate library at Mooseheart; to encourage more reading among their membership and the general public; and to promote at the same time the resources of their local libraries.

An annual book shower is held for Mooseheart with more than 20,000 volumes having been presented and, in addition, thousands of volumes have been placed in local, county and state institutions.
