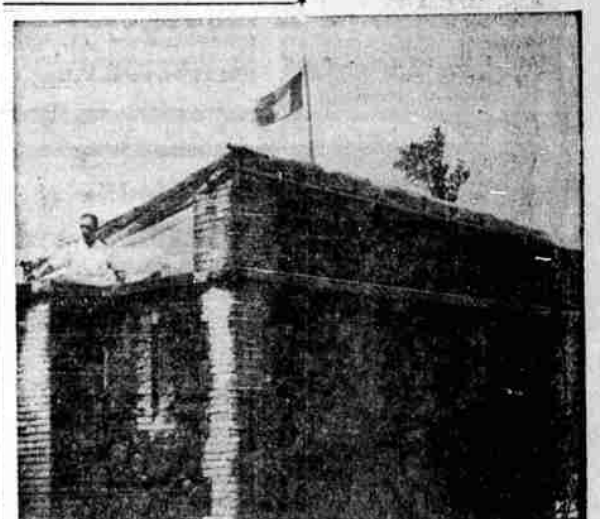
Governor May Get Pittman's Seat
