

COUNCIL FIXES NEW FEES FOR CITY LICENSES

Amendments fixing new license fees for barber shops, beauty salons and liquor service clubs within the city and a new ordinance rezoning the city under a revamped building code were adopted last night by city councilmen in the last regular meeting of 1940.

The council's adjournment is subject to the call of out-going Mayor Clifton Richmond for a meeting before the end of the year to clear up miscellaneous unfinished business. The next regular meeting will be Monday night, January 6.

Zone Stipulation
Final reading of the complicated zoning ordinance required more time than any other single item of business transacted. It stipulates that zones be created under numerical labels which limit the type of dwellings or business buildings than can be constructed, that local zone options be allowed, and that a board of appeals be created.

Under the ordinance the appeal board membership has been changed from three to five with five year terms. Local option for zone change is possible with permission of 100 per cent of the property holders within 200 feet of the proposed change.

Ordinance No. 2253, section 3, was amended to provide an annual license fee of \$25 for barber shops.

Fee Raised
The council also amended the ordinance regulating beauty parlors, providing an annual license fee of \$5.

The amendment to ordinance No. 3038, section 1, raising the annual license fee for liquor service clubs to \$300, affects the Embassy Town club, only such place of business within the city limits. The license fee was formerly \$400.

Councilman A. A. Montgom-

ery recommended that half-holidays for all personnel of the city be granted on Tuesday, December 24, and December 31, to supplement the regular full-day vacations on Christmas and New Year's day. The recommendation was accepted and passed in the form of a motion.

Valuation Fixed
Appraisers have tentatively fixed the valuation of certain property southeast of the airport, pending further development of that area under the recently announced CAA improvement program.

Valuation was fixed at \$100 per acre for upland or good farm land and \$25 per acre for lowland or land not of farming quality.

The appraisal was made by E. M. Chilcote, R. H. Dunbar and W. F. Sears.

Mayor Richmond announced that traffic lights on the new East Main street underpass had been turned off again after operating a few days in the Christmas season. It was explained that the lights created too much confusion, and will not be put into steady operation until lights on other city intersections are installed.

has been a "definite betterment" in conditions.

"We do not claim attainment," Mr. Roosevelt continued, "and we recognize there is much—oh so much—to do."

"Most of all we ask a chance to do it—yes, a peaceful chance to do it."

"We want to do it the voluntary way—and most human beings in all the world want to do it the voluntary way. We do not want to have the way imposed on the world by conquest of the world by the sword."

"That would not follow in the footsteps of Christ. That would not make for happier Christmases in the future of any nation. Mankind is all one—and what happens in distant lands tomorrow will leave its mark on the happiness of our Christmases to come."

While the British air force was busy over Germany, Nazi night raiders concentrated a heavy attack on England's industrial northwest.

Authorized British sources permitted identification of the area which bore the brunt of the assault merely as "Lancashire" (in which are situated the great cities of Liverpool and Manchester, both of which have been heavily bombed recently.)

A hospital, two shelters and a number of shops, houses and commercial buildings were reported destroyed or damaged.

Seven bodies were removed today from the wreckage of a tavern destroyed last night, and workers attempted rescue of persons believed trapped by heavy beams. One bomb fell directly in the middle of that crowded building, leveling the greater part.

The British assault coincided with reports of unusual activity along the German-occupied French coast, which led to speculation here that the Nazis might be planning a Christmas attempt to invade England.

here, it was defeated elsewhere. The present agreement is regional in scope.

Functioning of an agreement here will be contingent upon California growers putting into effect their pro-rata law, so that they will withhold the same grades withheld by the Oregon growers under the agreement.

The federal marketing agreement affects only potatoes in interstate commerce, while shipments to San Francisco markets from Shafter and other California districts are intra-state and must be controlled if at all by state law.

The agreement, once set up, will be continued indefinitely until thrown out.

Probst said similar agreements are now under consideration in Colorado, Idaho, North Dakota, Minnesota, Wisconsin, Michigan, Nebraska and Wyoming.

Growers of this area, it was brought out at the meeting, are also asking for a feed diversion program to divert No. 2 spuds for livestock feeding.

The matter of army and navy purchases of agricultural products received attention at the meeting, it being pointed out that industrial supplies are purchased at cost plus 10 per cent, while agricultural purchases are usually on a public bid, which serves to drive the price below the market levels.
