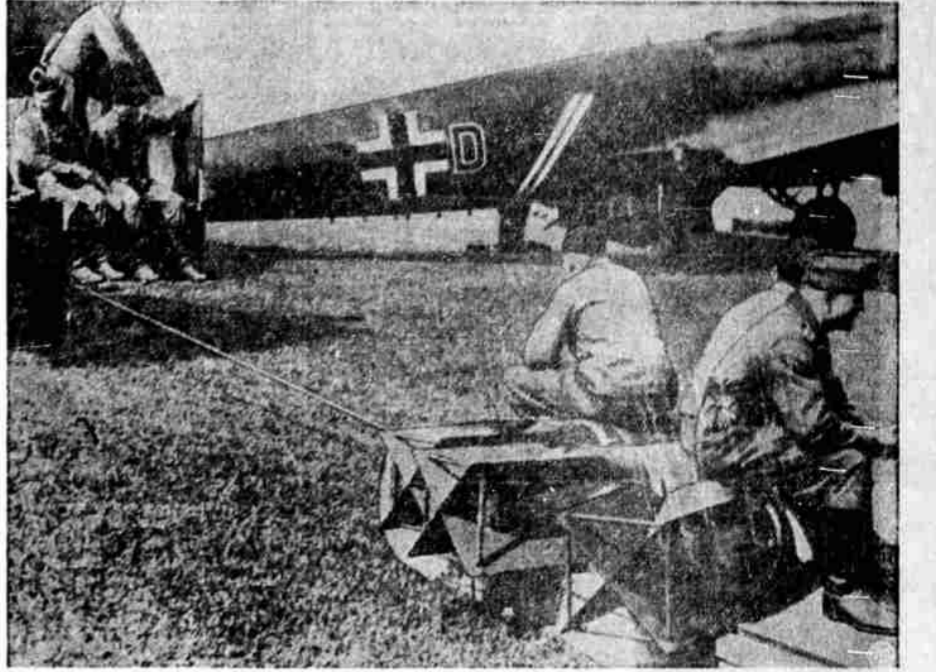

Load of Trouble for the R. A. F.



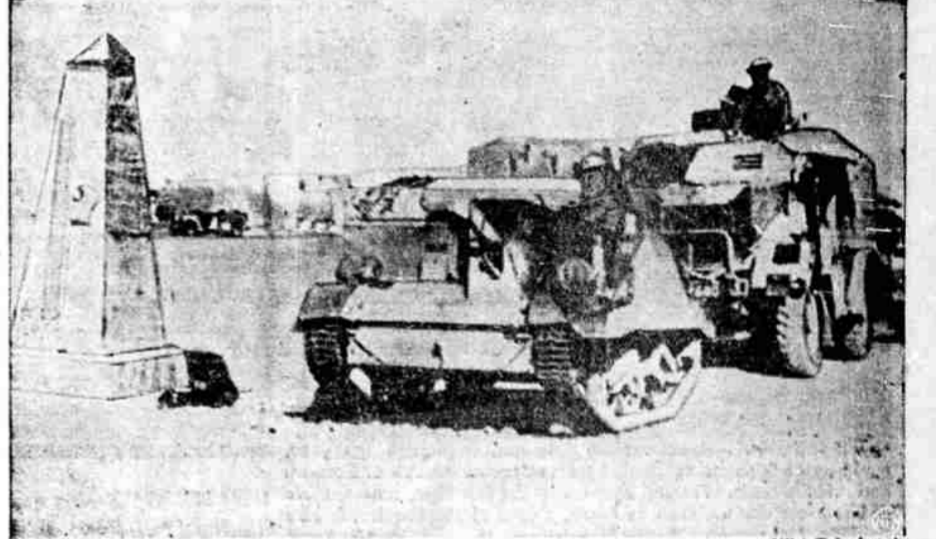

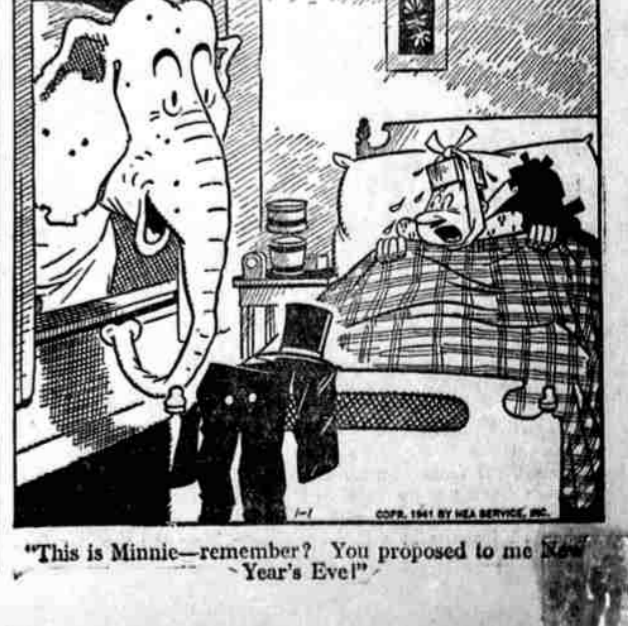
