

NOTED SPEAKER TO COME HERE LATE SATURDAY

The Rev. F. John Scroggie, for 25 years connected with the great banking firm of Barclay's in England and an outstanding British preacher, will arrive in Klamath Falls from San Francisco at 9:30 p. m. Saturday for a week of speaking engagements.

Besides rising from junior clerk to the presidency of Barclay's, Dr. Scroggie was trained as an operative tenor before becoming a minister.

Topics to be discussed by Dr. Scroggie in afternoon and evening meetings at the Presbyterian church were announced Friday by Rev. A. Theodore Smith, pastor, as follows:

Sunday morning, "Divine Glory"; 3 p. m., "Divine Government"; 7:30 p. m., "Divine Grace."

Monday at 2:30 p. m., "Prophecy and History"; 8 p. m., "The Path of Life."

Tuesday at 2:30, "A Threefold Rest"; 8 p. m., "The Ideal Life."

Wednesday at 2:30, "Visions"; 8 p. m., "The Influence of Life."

Thursday at 2:30, "Our Responsibility in Soul-Winning"; 8 p. m., "The Growth of Life."

Friday at 2:30, "The Midnight Hour of Human History"; 8 p. m., "The Glory of Life."

Mrs. Scroggie, who is also an outstanding speaker, will remain in San Francisco to complete engagements but will arrive here Monday evening and will be available for speaking engagements here.

"It is increasingly evident from reports on all sides," said Rev. Smith, "that Klamath Falls has the opportunity of hearing two outstanding citizens of the British empire. Two of my members heard Dr. Scroggie in Los Angeles and said he is the greatest preacher they ever heard. Others speak of his tremendous appeal to young people."

The Presbyterian young people are planning a potluck dinner Tuesday evening at 6:30, when both Dr. and Mrs. Scroggie will be present and will speak. The young people invite other young people of the city to this dinner, asking only that they contact the church to ascertain what to bring.

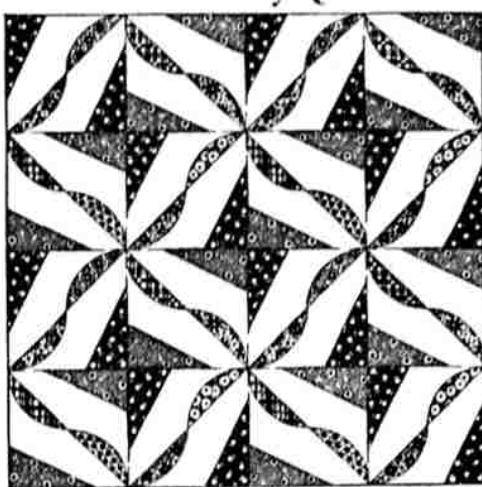
PRINCESS UNWANTED IN 25 COUNTRIES

SAN FRANCISCO, Feb. 7 (AP)—Nobody wants Princess Stefanie Hohenlohe of Hungary, it appeared last night, Stephen White, her attorney, said 25 nations so far have refused to issue her a visa and United States authorities already had told her she is not wanted in this country.

Princess Stefanie is free on bond awaiting final decision in the deportation action launched last December when she failed to take the hint she had best leave the country forthwith.

Let Labels Guide You When Buying Meat Cuts at Store

When you buy Sunday's roast of beef be sure you are getting the grade of meat you pay for. The department of agriculture has set up new beef grades. You'll find these grade marks over and over again on the whole length of the meat carcass.

PRIME: The highest grade of beef. Domestic consumers rarely see it.

CHOICE: Highest grade of beef commonly available to consumers. Usually cuts are relatively fat and require considerable trimming.

GOOD: This grade meets the needs of consumers who have small food budgets and want the best quality they can get for moderate prices. Carries enough fat for average needs, but not enough to require heavy trimming before serving.

COMMERCIAL: For consumers able to buy beef only if prices are below average. Has very little excess fat. Produced from steers and heifers and relatively young cows fed largely on grass or roughage. Inexpensive.

UTILITY: Lowest government meat usually available to consumers. Includes meats which are not tender but can be made palatable by careful and imaginative cooking. It should be sold at the lowest price.

Here's a delicious pot roast which can be made of U. S. Good or U. S. Commercial grade beef:

Pot Roast of Beef
(6 Servings With Leftovers)
Five lbs. rump, round or chuck of beef; 1 onion, sliced; 1/2 clove garlic, flour, salt, pepper, paprika, 2 cups stock made of leftover lettuce leaves or other greens, 1 tablespoon vinegar, 1 bay leaf, 2 carrots, cut into thick strips, 1 tablespoon butter, 1 tablespoon flour, 1/2 cup sour cream.

Wipe meat with clean damp cloth. Mix flour and seasoning, then dredge the meat. Use large iron or other heavy metal pot. Heat piece of suet, or ba-

con drippings. Brown roast well on all sides. Remove meat, then brown onion, garlic and carrot strips in drippings. Return meat to pot. Add vinegar and vegetable stock and bay leaf. Cover. Simmer (do not cook rapidly) until tender, between 3 and 4 hours. Turn meat occasionally and add more stock if necessary, but never have more than 2 cups of liquid. Combine butter and flour until smooth. Remove meat to hot platter. Add butter and flour to gravy; when gravy begins to thicken, stir in sour cream. Season well with paprika. Serve with a large dish of buttered noodles or potato pancakes.
