

AFL, RAILROADS CLASH ON STRIKE

PORTLAND, March 20 (AP)—AFL unions and railroad com-

panies continued their Montgomery Ward and company battle today. The unions, seeking railroad agreement to cut off all Ward freight, maintained pickets at rail warehouses, but allowed some freight to be delivered. Jack Estabrook, secretary of the Warehousemen's union, said

the Railway Express agency would be allowed to operate as the result of the agency's agreement to honor picket lines in 11 western states. Estabrook also said that teamsters were delivering all incoming "government and national defense shipments and 90 per cent of all other incoming freight." The railroad lines joined in a

statement which said, "The railroad freight warehouses have been picketed by unions striking against one business house, and the purpose is to stop the handling of its business, which the railroads cannot refuse to accept without violation of law." Looking for Bargains? Turn to the Classified page

Hood Stamp Rejected By Department

WASHINGTON, March 20 (AP)—The postoffice department said Monday it could see no way at present of issuing a three stamp depicting Oregon's Mount Hood but inferred it would consider

issuance of such a stamp as of historical significance. Senator McNary wrote the department sending a request from Henry M. Tomlinson of Portland that Mount Hood be depicted on a stamp. He enclosed a drawing by E. B. Quigley of Portland of the mountain. The department replied it could see no way of issuing such a stamp except un-

der the "historical" series and called attention that Tomlinson's letter offered no such reason. The department praised the drawing made by Quigley and said if it later was found such a stamp could be issued it would ask for return of the drawing. 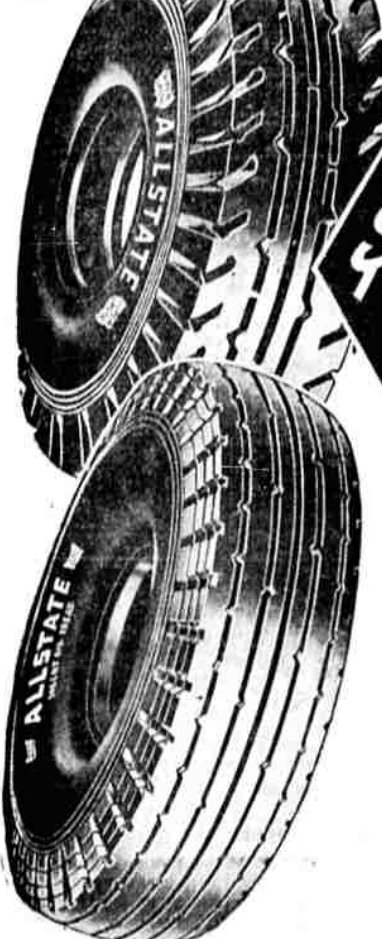

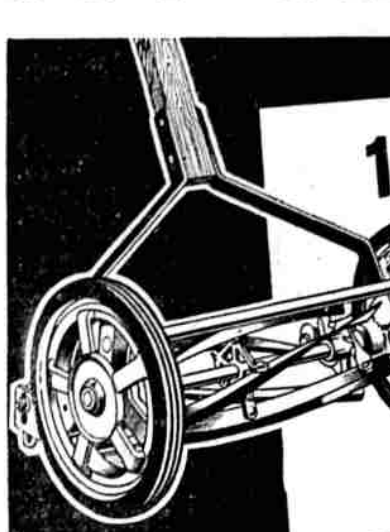
