

CITIZENSHIP CLASS TO BE SHOW GUESTS

Some 350 students from the city elementary schools will play "host" to Klamath's newest citizens Friday night at 8 o'clock when they present the story of "Americana" at the armory. The guests of honor will be the members of Mrs. H. M. Ackley's Citizenship Training class, who next month will become Uncle Sam's newest nephews and nieces.

This program is the annual presentation by the physical education department of the city schools. The story is that of the United States, told by dances as the Indians, early settlers, early Americans, and moderns appear in costume of the various periods to dance giving the highlights in history.

Headlines for the program will be Fremont's Indians, Mill's "Skaters," Fairview's "Cowboys," Roosevelt's acrobatic number, Pelican's "Pattern Waltz," Riverside's "Baseball" and Conger's "Stars and Stripes Forever." Twenty-six numbers in all will be presented with everything from rope twirling to ballet steps featured.

A small charge will be made with proceeds placed in the physical education fund of the schools.

Third Big Bomber Visits Portland

PORTLAND, Ore., March 20 (P)—The third of 22 4-motor Boeing bombers bound for Britain stopped at the Portland airport briefly to overtake the first two ships at an overnight halt at Boise.

Nineteen others will follow the path of the first three, being ferried across the United States by U. S. air corps pilots. The planes will be flown to Montreal, Canada, where the British will take charge under sealed orders.

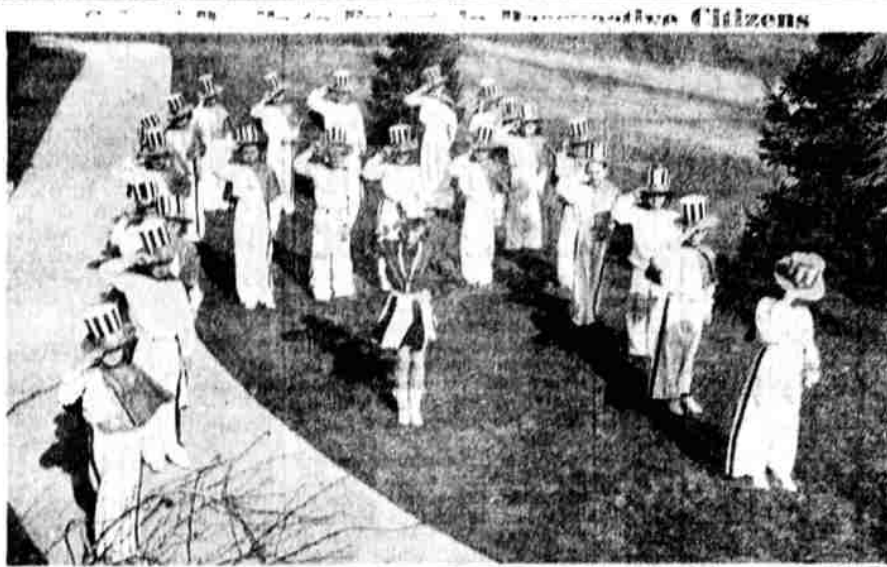
Honker Defies Honking Cars on Portland Street

Banker Advises Cities to Avoid New Indebtedness

EUGENE, March 20 (P)—The national armament program may stimulate tax collections, but cities should not become optimistic on that account, Abbot L. Mills Jr., vice president of the United States National Bank of Portland, warned last night.

He advised the Oregon Finance Officers' association, meeting in conjunction with the 19th annual commonwealth conference on the University of Oregon campus, that municipal indebtedness should be avoided during the next few years.

"It would be building on shifting sands to look on effects of any emergency condition of this sort as anything but temporary," he said.

Clerical Help For Legislature Costs \$71,900

SALEM, March 20 (P)—Cost of stenographers and clerks in the 1941 legislature totaled \$71,900, the state department disclosed here yesterday. Cost of the 1939 session, which was four days longer, was \$79,578. Clerks for the house cost \$44,279 in 1941 and \$47,047 in 1939. In the senate clerks cost \$26,047 in 1941 and \$32,564 in 1939.
