

## PORTLAND BANKS, BUSINESS SOAR

PORTLAND, April 1 (P) — Defense and taxes gave Portland a substantial March business record and set an all-time high in bank clearings.

Federal Reserve bank staff members credited a record volume of income tax payments with sending clearings to \$189,894,572, compared with \$158,927,343 for the same month last year and more than \$180,000,000 last October.

Building permits totaled 505 for \$1,648,830, topping any month since September, 1930. Included were permits for 145 residences, to cost \$635,000.

Foreign wheat shipments, wholly inactive for three months, revived with the shipment of 551,066 bushels, valued at \$420,895 and comparing with 432,658 bushels worth \$371,609 shipped a year ago.

Flour shipments reached 34,971 barrels, costing \$115,437 against 127,767 barrels with a total value of \$365,965 for the same month last year.

Lumber shipments dropped substantially, with only 3,367,690 board feet worth \$263,172 moving. In March, 1940, lumber amounted to 10,479,027 board feet valued at \$360,515.

The month's total foreign trade was valued at \$1,785,546, somewhat under the \$2,096,296 shipped in March, 1940, and \$2,417,580 exported in March, 1939.

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## M'NARY, HOLMAN AID RUST CONTROL

WASHINGTON, April 1 (P) — Oregon's senators, McNary and Holman, played an important role before the senate agriculture committee in getting funds for white pine blister rust control increased \$250,000 to a total of \$1,409,000.

The agriculture bill (HR3735), reported to the senate Thursday, contained the increase over the house figure. It was up for consideration Monday.

Agriculture officials testified there was considerable rust in Crater Lake national park and that it was spreading southward toward Yosemite national park.

They said they were anxious for enough funds to keep ahead of the disease so the government would not lose the susceptible species which are exposed to the disease in the park.

Under questioning by McNary, the officials said the disease was introduced into this country from abroad and found in southern Oregon in 1936 and in the northern part of the state in 1925.

The senators also took a keen interest in funds for continuing research for growing fiber flax in this country. Officials said the supply of fiber in the United States was small and little linen was manufactured in the United States. They said 9000 tons of flax straw were grown in Oregon last year.

Holman also urged an increase of \$200,000 in the amount appropriated for the forest service to range use.

He told the committee that grazing of domestic livestock was a very important use of national forests and that more men should be employed in range management problems.

The forest service amount was increased \$1,130,000, above the house figure of \$18,022,455 authorized in the house measure.
