

MARCH FIGURES SHOW BUILDING GAIN FOR CITY

A gain of \$21,066 over March of last year was noted by City Building Inspector Harold Franey as he closed March, 1941, books and reported a total of \$100,505 spent for building within the city limits for the past 31 days.

Residences, of which 12 high-type houses were under construction, led the permit total with \$46,500.

Following is the report issued by Franey:

Residences, new, 12, \$46,500; residences, remodel, 27, \$11,845; business, new, 1, \$16,000; business, remodel, 10, \$10,600; industrial, new, 1, \$3,000; garages, private, 4, \$550; roof structure, 1, \$800; poster panels, 4, \$175; rescue mission, \$5,000; awning, 1, \$35; total permits, 62; total, \$100,505.

In March, 1940, 50 permits were issued totaling \$78,539, showing a gain of 12 permits totaling \$21,066. For the first quarter, of 1940, 115 permits were issued at a total of \$201,739, as compared to 133 permits issued for the first quarter of 1941, or a total of \$188,645, or an increase of 18 permits but a loss of \$13,094.
