This time of year we get the garments away from the depot the moment they come to us with as little delay as possible, so you can imagine the delight this huge consignment from Bundles for Britain will give to countless recipients. We are all very much impressed with the way the garments are packed; they arrived over here in perfect condition. The label attached to each article conveying the sympathy from our friends in America will warm the hearts of the wearers as much as the wool itself will warm their bodies.
