Klamath's Festival of Skits

THE most ambitious enterprise of its kind ever attempted in this area came to a successful climax Friday night in the Klamath County Skits Festival held at the Klamath Union high school auditorium. Program for this entertaining event was composed of the winning skits from competitive presentations in communities throughout the county. Altogether, 76 skits were presented in 12 district festivals preliminary to the final county festival Friday night.

Purpose of the festival is to stimulate interest in drama as a form of recreation, to provide opportunity to develop better club, community and county entertainment programs, and to recognize outstanding talent in acting, directing and stage mechanics. Sponsor was the Oregon State college extension service in home economics.

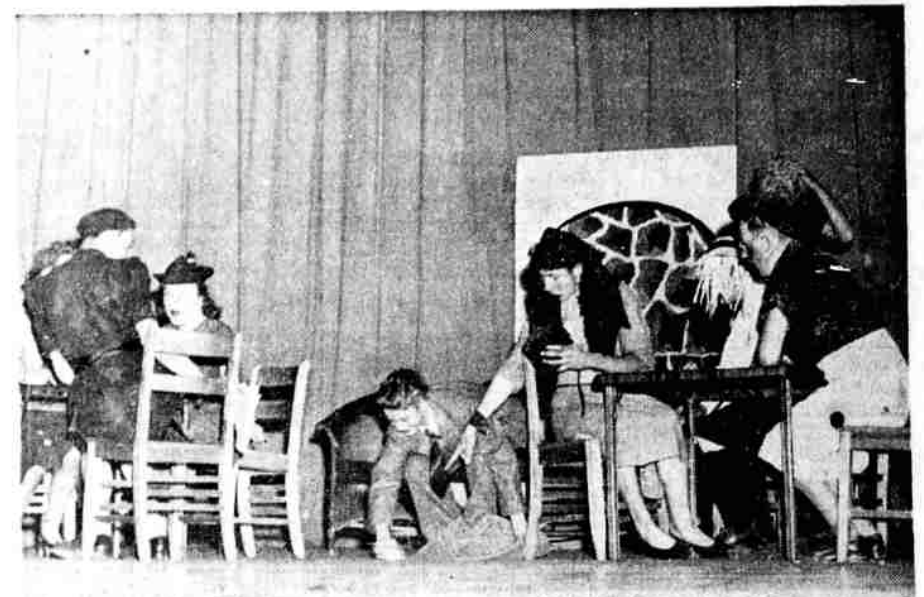

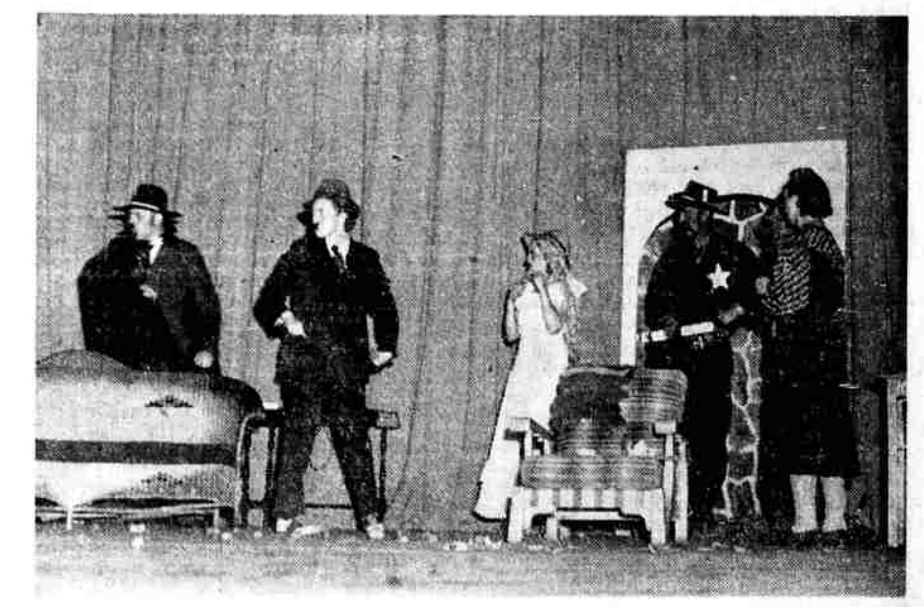
