

## PAUL ROBESON TO LEAD 1942 CONCERT LIST

Paul Robeson, great Negro singer and actor, will be the first artist to appear on the 1941-42 program of the Klamath Community Concert Association, it was announced Thursday by George A. Myers, president of the organization.

Word that Robeson would sing here with enthusiasm by music lovers—his appearance next fall to be Robeson's first in southern Oregon. The singer is considered the outstanding member of his race and one of the greatest living American artists and it is a tribute to the local "artists committee" which chooses the concert numbers, that they have been able to book Robeson this year.

The annual membership drive of the Concert association starts Monday with a meeting of all workers at the Willard hotel at 6:30 p. m. Although this year has been considered tops in musical performances in Klamath Falls, the committee hopes to present even greater attractions this coming season. Paul Robeson's appearance guarantees one of the outstanding programs ever heard in this city.

Robeson is considered more than a great singer or a great actor; there is a heightened mood of mysticism in his singing as though he had penetrated the soul of his people. In spirit he is the mouthpiece of folk music, and there is no greater folk singer in the world today.

Adult tickets will be sold for \$5. It was announced, the ticket admitting the holder to all concerts on the series. As in past years there will be no admittance to concerts except on presentation of tickets purchased during the drive.

## DUTCH ELIMINATE SCOUT MOVEMENT

AMSTERDAM, (via Berlin), April 10 (AP)—The Boy Scout movement was officially abolished in The Netherlands Wednesday.

A statement said the boys belonged to the International Boy Scouts which in the Nazi view constitutes an instrument of British cultural and political propaganda.

It was pointed out that scout troops paraded and held exercises contrary to the German occupation orders.

Dissolution of the Dutch Salvation Army which took place two weeks ago has not yet been officially announced. The 700 paid members are to be given other jobs.
