

Daisy Cake and Mint Sherbets Delicious for Easter Feast



Delightful Easter possibility is frosted chocolate butterscotch cake.

Glistening white, delicate yellow and cool green are spring-like colors. A rich, beautifully frosted daisy cake served with sherbet glasses of fresh mint and lemon ice will bring any Easter dinner to a spring-like and satisfying close.

Fresh Mint and Lemon Ice

Half cup lump sugar (tablets), 4 medium-sized thin-skinned lemons, 1 cup hot water, 2 cups cold water, 1 cup granulated sugar, 4 tablespoons crushed fresh mint leaves.

Rub entire surface of lump sugar over rind of lemons which have been washed and spiced until dry. Over this lemon-flavored sugar, pour a cup of lemon juice, combined with the hot water. Add crushed mint leaves. Stir until sugar is thoroughly dissolved, then add the cold water, into which has been stirred the granulated sugar. Cover, strain and freeze in hand freezer, using 3 parts of ice and 1 part of rock salt. Serve in sherbet cups and garnish with mint leaves.

Daisy Cake

Two cups sifted cake flour, 1 teaspoon soda, 1 teaspoon salt, 4 cup butter or other shortening, 11 cups brown sugar, firmly packed, 2 eggs or 3 egg yolks, unbeaten, 3 squares unsweetened chocolate, melted, 1 cup milk, 1 teaspoon vanilla.

Sift flour once, measure, add soda and salt, and sift together three times. Cream butter thoroughly, add sugar gradually, and cream together until light and fluffy. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each; then add chocolate and blend. Add flour, alternately with milk, a small amount at a time, beating after each addition until smooth. Add vanilla. Bake in two greased deep 9-inch layer pans or three greased 8-inch layer pans in moderate oven (350 degrees F.) 25 to 30 minutes. Spread Seven Minute frosting between layers and on top and sides of cake. Double recipe for three 10-inch layers. Cake may be decorated with daisies made with pastry tube, or yellow flowers may be bought ready-made and placed on frosting.

TRADE HITS PEAK IN EASTER PERIOD

NEW YORK, April 11 (AP) — This week's retail trade reached a new peak for the year "in a spectacular climax of the pre-Easter selling period," Dun & Bradstreet reported today in its weekly survey.

The review cited reports from many centers telling of the best Easter business since the record high 12 years ago.

"For all retail trade," it said, "including food volume, which ran about 12 per cent higher, the advance over the 1940 level was estimated at 15 to 18 per cent."

Gains were well distributed regionally, although city reports showed the broadest increases still tended to cluster in the south and middle west.
