

HEALTH GROUP TO HEAR TALK BY PORTLANDER

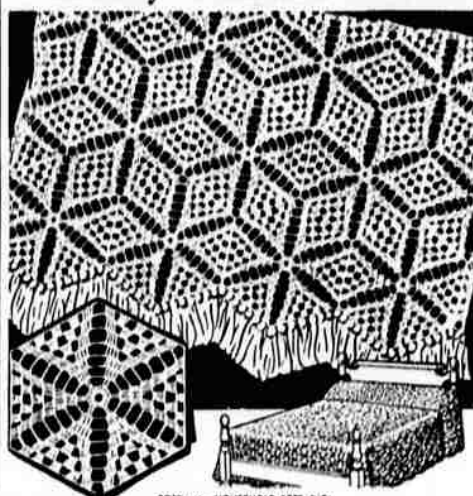
Dr. Ralph C. Matson, a prominent Portland physician who will be a guest in Klamath Falls Friday to be guest speaker at the annual dinner meeting of the Klamath County Public Health association, has a long list of hospital affiliations as well as years of outstanding service to his profession during which he has specialized in treatment of tuberculosis.

Dr. Matson is chief surgeon of the University State Tuberculosis hospital at Portland, one of the two state universities in the country that maintains a chest surgical hospital; is director of the department of surgery, Portland Open Air sanatorium at Milwaukie; is attending specialist at the chest surgical center, Veterans Administration hospital, Portland; is consulting thoracic surgeon at Doernbecher Memorial hospital for children at Portland.

At the Multnomah county hospital, Dr. Matson is chest consultant; is associate clinical professor of thoracic surgery at the University of Oregon Medical school and also associate clinical professor of medicine at this school; is a member of the executive faculty of the medical school, a member of the visiting staff of the Good Samaritan hospital at Portland.

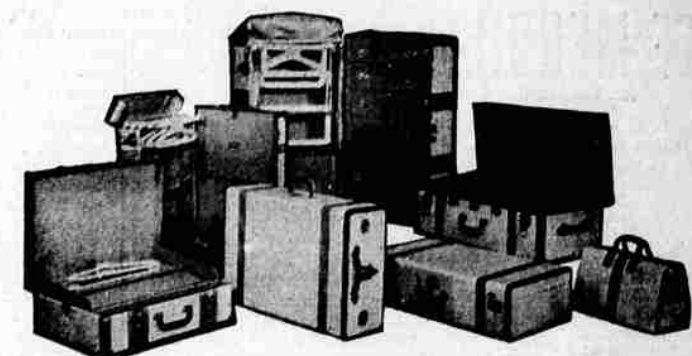
