WHEAT REGISTERS FRACTIONAL GAINS

CHICAGO, May 21 (P)—Scattered buying attributed to mills and professional interests enabled the wheat market to register fractional gains today that put prices only slightly below the 12 months' peak established earlier in the week.

Strength was borrowed from corn, soybeans and lard, which reached new highs since 1937. Corn advanced more than a cent at one stage to above 75 for September delivery while soybeans were up 3 to 4 cents to as high as \$1.43 1/2 for May delivery.

Wheat closed 1/8c higher than yesterday, May \$1.01 1/2, July \$1.00-1.00 1/4; corn 1/4c higher, May 73 1/2c, July 74 1/2c; oats 1/4c up.
