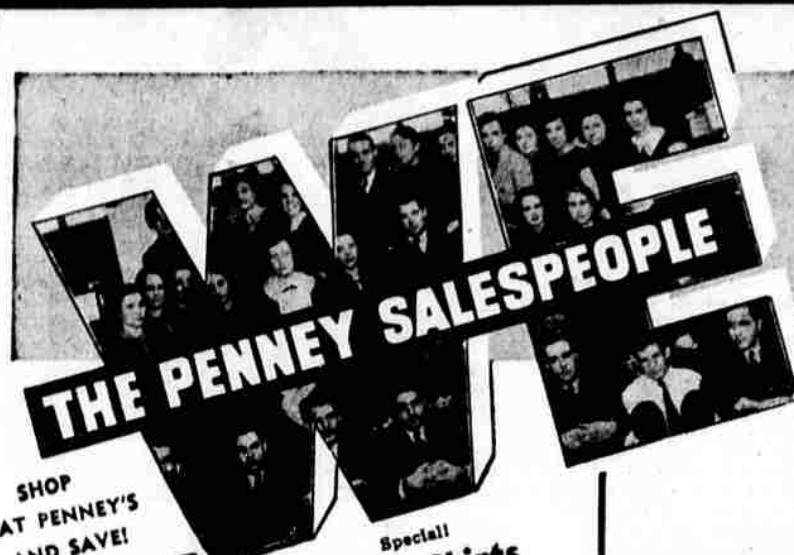
duties. Mrs. Yarnes and young son, Charles, will accompany Yarnes north.

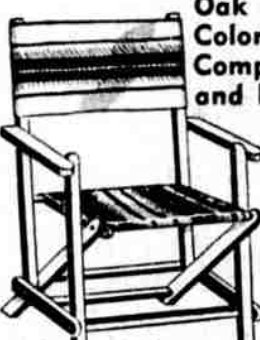
