

CHURCH TO BE USED IN DRAFT REGISTRATION

The Beatty church has been established as a supplementary registration point in Klamath county for the second national draft registration on July 1, local selective service headquarters said Wednesday.

All American and alien youths who have reached the age of 21 since October 16, 1940, date of the first draft registration, must register for possible military service next Tuesday by order of President Roosevelt.

About 400 Klamath county men will sign up, according to a draft board estimate.

Chief Klamath registration point will be in the selective service headquarters in the basement of the county courthouse, but supplementary stations will be set up in Beatty, Gilchrist and the Klamath Agency for the convenience of youths living in outlying districts. Definite points in Gilchrist and the Agency will be announced later.

Registration may be made at any time Tuesday between the hours of 7 a. m. and 9 p. m.

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Employers Must Get Approval of Medical Contracts

SALEM, June 26—All on-the-job medical contracts entered into by firms which have rejected coverage under the Industrial Accident Commission must be approved by the commission before becoming effective. Under

the new law passed by the recent legislature, rejected firms should submit such contracts to the commission along with a \$5 fee, Chairman C. M. Ryerson said today.

Under no circumstances will employees of rejected firms be permitted to contribute to the cost of medical or hospital services for on-the-job injuries, Ryerson pointed out.

"The commission soon will issue a revised hospital contract," said Chairman Ryerson. "We also are considering a readjustment of contract rates to be announced in a few days."

Under senate bill 298, rejected firms must submit on-the-job contracts to the commission and pay a \$5 fee for supervision. "Employers who reject the industrial commission coverage

may at their own expense contract for medical services. The commission will approve no contract which provides for payment of any part of the cost of such medical services by the employees."
