CHURCHILL'S SPEECH HITS TOUCHY SPOT

I have been encountering a very considerable expression of regret, not unmixed with quiet resentment, that British Prime Minister Churchill should have seen fit while addressing the house of commons to state that the United States "is advancing in rising wrath and conviction to the very verge of war."

When one considers the undoubted brilliance of the Churchill mind, and the fact that he is ranked as one of the great masters of the English language, it is difficult to believe that his remark was due to inadvertence. Maybe he felt that the American people are slow in making up their minds, and wanted to jog us a bit.

We Yankees are a peculiar people. One of our many idiosyncrasies is that while we are quite willing to do battle if we think we ought to, still we dislike being pushed into a fight by outsiders.

No, I'll take that word "outsiders" back. Mr. Churchill is our very good friend and "English cousin"—is half American himself, for that matter, on his mother's side. But in the very closeness of the American and British peoples lies the danger of trespass in each others affairs.

There are, for example, British folk who believe that the United States regards Canada as a providence of this country. And to get back to our muttons, there are more than a few Americans who are convinced that England looks upon the United States as part and parcel of the British commonwealth of nations, and so subject to the guidance of the mother country.

I hasten to add that there is no suggestion Mr. Churchill harbors any such nonsensical idea. However, the belief of some Americans that this attitude exists in England has been encouraged by the maneuvers of more than one of the army of British propagandists who have been operating in this country ever since the outbreak of the war.

For the most part these workers from overseas haven't overreached the mark. Unfortunately this hasn't always been true, for every once in a while a Briton with a crusading gleam in his eyes has landed on our shores with the idea of telling us a few things for the good of our crude souls.

For instance, the other day Colonel Josiah Wedgwood, British member of parliament, was quoted by the New York Journal American as asserting that (1) America ought to go to war, that (2) the "best people" don't go to congress, and that (3) Senator Wheeler was a "wretched appeaser" and should "go soak his head."

Well, of course that's an extreme case which cropped up in hot weather when people's judgment is likely to wander. Most Britons would resent such an outburst as much as Americans do, and would point out that the good colonel was speaking for himself and not for his country. As a matter of fact he himself later expressed regret that he had roughed some folk the wrong way.

New Section of Coast Highway To Open Sunday

WHEELER, Ore., Aug. 1 (UP)—A free salmon bake and treasure hunt will mark the opening of the new Neahkahnie highway Sunday.

Organizations from both Tillamook and Clatsop counties are sponsoring the dedication of the new road, a short cut which cuts the distance between Wheeler, little town on the Oregon coast, and Seaside by six miles and eliminates many curves.

The new route follows the coast line closely, and passes the newly-created Short Sand beach state park, a primitive area heretofore accessible only by a hazardous trail above the sheer cliffs of Neahkahnie mountain or over rugged Cape Falcon.

Canadian Division Reaches England

A BRITISH PORT, Aug. 1 (AP)—The Canadian army's third division arrived today in the United Kingdom after a speedy Atlantic crossing to join the Canadian forces, rapidly becoming one of the strongest military formations of the empire.

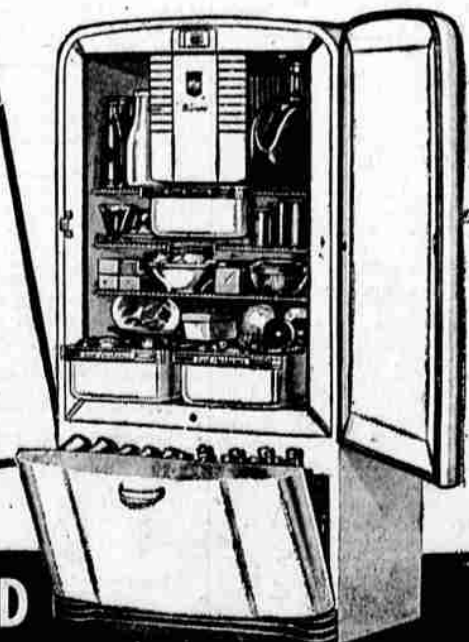
