

WARD STORE PROTESTS ON JOBLESS PAY

SALEM, Aug. 21 (AP)—Montgomery Ward and company appealed to the state unemployment compensation commission Wednesday from a decision by its referee, who held that 750 employees of the store who were out of work during the store's closing from May 3 to July 31 should be paid between \$50,000 and \$75,000 in benefits.

The company, asking that a special referee be appointed to conduct a new hearing or that the commission review the case,

said the referee's ruling was based on insufficient and incorrect information.

The company's points in the appeal are that the closing of the Portland branch by a labor dispute was not permanent, that pickets continued on the job during the closure, that the claimants were unemployed as a direct result of a labor dispute and thus are ineligible to benefits, and that the settlement of the strike on July 26 does not bar re-employment of non-union workers.

The commission said it would decide next week whether to grant a new hearing.

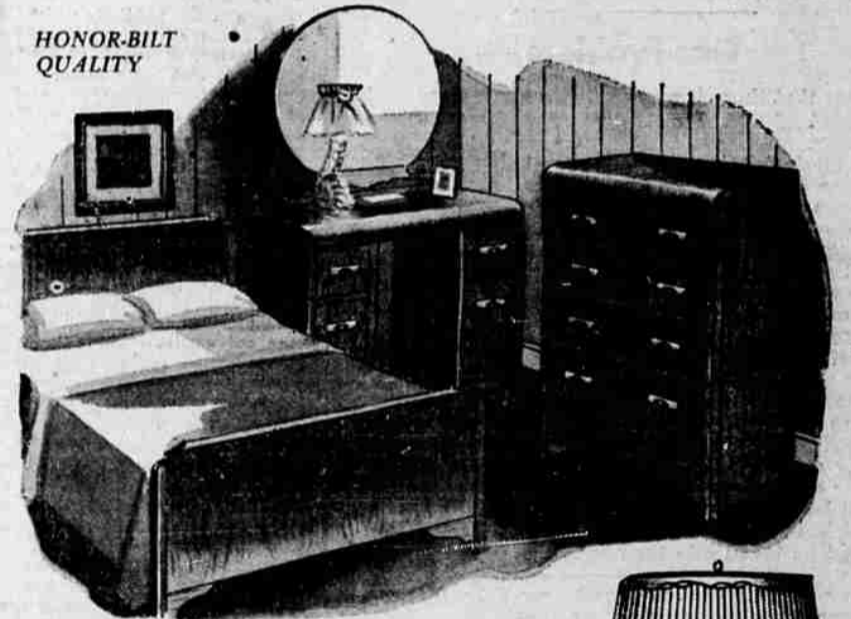
