

## SERB RESISTANCE NEAR REBELLION

LONDON, Oct. 16 (AP)—A Yugoslav legation spokesman said today that Serbian resistance to German rule had reached the status of rebellion with an armed force of 80,000 led by army officers opposing German rule.

Armed bands are making travel impossible on Serbian roads by firing on every automobile. One group fired a munition dump in an attack on Smederevo, 20 miles from Belgrade, he said.

He asserted that Italian tactics of burning villages suspected of

sheltering the rebels have failed and that axis garrisons control few cities.

## WCTU Speaker Hits Liquor Advertising

PORTLAND, Oct. 16 (AP)—Oregon homes are being invaded by "psychological appeals" to drink liquor, Oregon WCTU members were told here last night by Mrs. Margaret C. Munns, Evanston, Ill.

The treasurer of the National Women's Christian Temperance Union said that although Oregon's laws forbade advertising designed to "gain new addicts," they were being nullified by "appeals through radio and national magazine advertising."

She said that the only final solution was legislation to prohibit manufacture and sale of liquor.

community halls or grange halls. Many hours of happiness can be enjoyed this winter by both young and old who participate in joining swing clubs or participate in swing activities after organization meetings. Schools can introduce the activity during the noon hour and after school as it is done at the Cheyenne Mountain school at Colorado Springs.

Izola Jensen, extension specialist in community social organization, spent one week dancing with Dr. Lloyd Shaw's dancers at Cheyenne Mountain school this summer. She enjoyed the fun of dancing at the Acacia park at one of the weekly park dances. She also enjoyed a "Twistification" at the school gymnasium.

Miss Jensen will spend two nights in Klamath county this year giving training meetings

and helping local groups so that they can include the "cowboy dances" as Dr. Shaw calls them in their program.

On October 22, Miss Jensen will give intensive training to two sets of four couples each, who will act as demonstration groups on the night of October 23. Any organization or group who wish to review or learn these old-time dances, is invited to bring four couples (four men and four women), a caller and a leader to the meeting on October 23 at 8 p. m. in the Fremont school. Groups are requested to

register with Winnifred K. Gillen, home demonstration agent, Federal building, if they plan to send a group to the square dance training meeting.
