### YOUTH COMPLETES COURSE IN RADIO

When 300 radio communication students gathered at commencement exercises in the radio operating hangar at Scott Field, Ill., recently, Private Bob J. Mitchell was among the graduates to receive a diploma for his excellence and efficiency, according to Col. Wolcott P. Hayes, commandant.

Son of Mr. and Mrs. Joe J. Mitchell, Rt. 3, Box 194, Klamath Falls, Ore. Pvt. Mitchell completed last week a 22-week

intensive course in radio theory and mechanics which has qualified him to be sent to Hamilton Field, Calif. as an expert technician.

Graduates last week were addressed and congratulated by Capt. Carl Swyter, supervisor of the aircraft radio division of the army's radio university, who told the graduates that they were vital keys in national defense regardless of the post to which they were being sent.

Although Scott Field has been graduating approximately 300 radio technicians every two weeks, the post will be expanded by the end of this year to a capacity of 20,000 graduates every year, making the university the largest school of its kind in the country. The school is

open to all enlisted men or selectees who have a high school education or its equivalent.

### Air Corps Offers Flight Training To Enlisted Men

Some of the young enlisted men of the army of the United States who formerly watched with envy as pilots of the air corps flew the sleek ships of the modern air force overhead, or who scurried into the underbrush when an attack plane zoomed at them in maneuvers, may now shed their ground anchors and do the flying and zooming themselves, Sgt. Frank J. Huhin, postoffice building, U.

S. army recruiting officer, said today.

The army's rapidly increasing plane power offers opportunity for enlisted men to become pilots, he pointed out, and for those groundlings who dreamed of winging through space at the controls of some of the best military airplanes in the world, opportunity is knocking.

"Their ship is coming in," Sgt. Huhin put it, "Only it's not the story book ship laden with wealth and fortune—it's an airplane, ready to speed them into the future as swiftly as man can travel."

Enlisted men who are high school graduates, who are single, between 18 and 22 years old and in good physical condition, may become aviation stu-

dents, he said. In addition, the applicant agrees to serve for three years as an enlisted pilot if he successfully completes his pilot training. At the conclusion of his training he receives the rank of staff sergeant pilot, and takes his place as an important part of the swiftly growing air force of the United States.
