FOOTBALL BRIEFS

SEATTLE, Oct. 21 (AP)—Coach Jim Phelan ordered intensified practice in aerial defense today as he drilled the Washington football squad for Saturday's football clash here with Stanford. Scrimmage was the dish for tomorrow, with the emphasis still to be on the feared passing arm of Frankie Albert. PALO ALTO, Calif., Oct. 21 (AP)—Stanford was down to its last quarterback today, and Coach Clark Shaughnessy fitted reserves into key positions for the crippled Indian football team's crucial game with Washington at Seattle Saturday. Substitute quarterbacks R a y Hammett and Ray Durham, under studies to All-American Frankie Albert, were both laid out with injuries, and definitely out of the Husky contest. Albert was in good shape, but Shaughnessy was considering shifting him to left half to replace injured Pete Kmetovic. CORVALLIS, Ore., Oct. 21 (AP)—Boyd Clement, sophomore center, moved into the varsity lineup at Oregon State College today as the Beavers prepared for Saturday's game against Washington State College at Pullman. Clement replaced Quentin Greenough, regular center injured in the Beavers' victory over Stanford. Stiner intensified drill today, pointing out that Southern California, the only team to defeat O. S. C. this year, barely nosed out Washington State, 7-6, last week. EUGENE, Ore., Oct. 21 (AP)—University of Oregon, leading the Coast conference race with three straight wins, and one loss, drilled today on ways to stop University of California at Los Angeles' Q-T formation. The freshman squad shot U. C. L. A. plays at the varsity, specializing in passes. Scout Manny Vezie warned Coach Tex Oliver that the Uclians' Ted Forbes was an unerring passer. Oliver said defensive play would be stressed again tomorrow, after which the Ducks will train for the Saturday game at Los Angeles. LOS ANGELES, Oct. 21 (AP)—The University of California at Los Angeles Bruins may have more reserves against conference-leading Oregon Saturday than when they were beaten by Washington last week. They received no serious injuries in the Husky battle and Center Gene Alder and Tackle Jack Finlay probably were ready to return to the Halfback Howard Hunsaker cracked a pair of ribs. Stanford game, also ready.
