

# NEW SECRET NAVY WEAPON DISCLOSED

WASHINGTON, Nov. 27 (AP)—Existence of a secret navy weapon for use in detecting both ships and airplanes at great distances was disclosed in authoritative quarters Thursday as the navy department called for increased enlistments for training in radio maintenance.

The device has been in use for some time, according to the best available information, but has been a carefully guarded secret. Word of its existence leaked out in connection with the campaign of recruiting radio technicians, but even so navy officials declined all official discussion of it.

The recruiting campaign was disclosed in a letter issued to the recruiting service by Rear Admiral C. W. Nimitz, chief of the bureau of navigation, asking that special efforts be made to meet the demands of the expanding navy for trained radio experts.

To qualify, it was said, the men enlisting must have had experience in the design, construction and operation of amateur or commercial radio transmitting and receiving equipment or they may have had experience with television or cathode ray equipment.

The nature of the detection device despite disclosure regarding its existence, remained a naval secret. Whether it is similar to the radio airplane detection equipment now being widely used by military forces both in this country and in England could not be determined.

Her own favorite dishes stem from her Milwaukee background and suggest the flavor of German cooking.

### ROAST VEAL WITH RAISIN SAUCE

(Serves 8 to 10)  
Three and one-half pounds loin of veal, 1 cup larding fat, 3 onions, 2 carrots, 1 heaping tablespoonful of butter melted, salt, pepper, 4 cup of raisins, 1 tablespoonful of butter, 2 tablespoonfuls of flour, 1 teaspoonful of sugar, 1 tablespoonful of vinegar, 1 teaspoonful of lemon juice.

Cover the loin of veal thoroughly with the larding fat, then place it in a deep meat pan, seasoning it with salt and pepper to taste. Slice the onions and carrots and place them over the meat. Pour the melted butter over the roast. Cook 40 minutes, turning the roast until it is evenly browned on all sides. Then cover with the sauce, made by melting the butter in a saucepan, stirring in the flour and cooking this combination until brown, then adding the raisins, sugar, vinegar and lemon juice, mixing thoroughly, and allowing to simmer until the raisins are soft.

### SAUERKRAUT WITH APPLES

(Serves 6 to 8)  
Two pounds of sauerkraut, 4 tablespoonfuls of larding fat, 4 apples, 2 potatoes, 1 teaspoonful of caraway seed, 1 onion sliced, 3 tablespoonfuls of water, salt, sugar.

Peel, core and quarter the apples, then place with sauerkraut in an earthenware casserole, garnish with sliced onion and adding larding fat and water. Cover the casserole and cook on a medium flame until sauerkraut and apples are tender. Pare the potatoes and grate finely, adding to the casserole mixture. Add the caraway seed and season with salt and sugar to taste. Cook 30 minutes more.
