

FLEET TO ADVISE AIRCRAFT PLANTS

SAN DIEGO, Calif., Nov. 28 (AP)—Instead of retiring from the plane-building field if his interest in the Consolidated Aircraft corporation is acquired by the Vultee Aircraft, Inc., Major Reuben H. Fleet intends to stay on in the "even bigger" job of adviser to both companies.

This decision, Major Fleet said in a statement, not only represents his own choice but fulfills a government request. "I consider it my patriotic duty," the Consair president remarked.

Fleet's statement followed an announcement that Vultee, of Downey, Calif., and Aviation corporation, which owns an interest in Vultee, were negotiating to acquire, probably through an exchange of stock, the controlling shares in the great San Diego bomber building plant held by Fleet and members of his family.

"By no means am I withdrawing," he said. "The job before me is even bigger than before. Turning over management details of Consolidated to younger men and becoming an adviser to both Consolidated Aircraft and Vultee Aircraft, will enable me better to serve my country in this period of need than has been possible previously."

Consolidated builds long-distance land and sea bombing planes for the United States army and navy and for the anti-fascist nations abroad. It employs more than 30,000 at its San Diego plant and has present contracts exceeding \$750,000,000.

Vultee, specialist in training planes and small fighters, holds some \$155,000,000 in military and naval orders.

Bids on Shasta Dam Fish Hatchery To Be Delayed

SACRAMENTO, Nov. 28 (AP)—Postponement of the opening of bids for construction of additional facilities in connection with the Shasta dam fish conservation program was announced by the US bureau of reclamation today.

The bureau was scheduled to open bids today for building a hatchery on Battle creek in southern Shasta county, and other offers tomorrow for an adjacent warehouse and garage. Proposals for both projects will be opened December 4 instead.

Bureau officials said the postponement was due to a change in the wage scale effecting an increase in pay for carpenters who will be employed in the construction. At the same time, they announced bids will be opened December 18 for six residences at the hatchery site.

The fish control program is designed to provide salmon a "detour" to an insurmountable obstacle—Shasta dam itself—to their annual migration from the Pacific ocean to the upper reaches of the Sacramento river and tributary streams.

Portland Expects Large Fire Year
PORTLAND, Nov. 28 (AP)—Portland will suffer its greatest fire loss in a decade this year, Fire Marshal Fred W. Roberts said Monday night. Sunday's estimated \$200,000 blaze at the Arden Farms company building carried the year's total so far over \$900,000.

Losses during 1940 totaled only \$450,561.

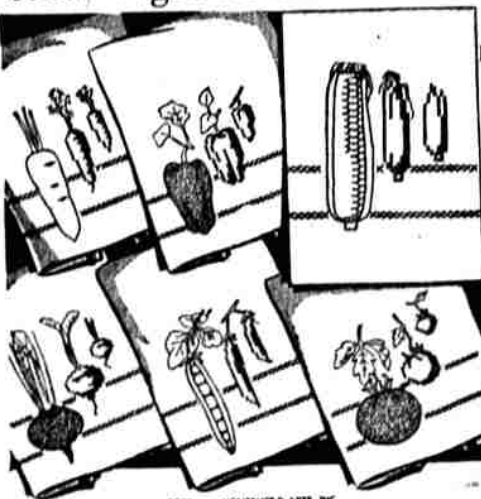

YOUNG EASTERN KILLERS CAUGHT

CUMBERLAND, Ky., Nov. 27 (AP)—Two 18-year-old boys who were arrested in the slaying of Ward Loveless, 51, Washington attorney, were returned to Virginia Thursday, several hours after their capture.

E. D. Helms of the Leesburg, Va., police department, said the youths, Paul Bernard Hoback, 18, Bluefield, W. Va., and Tommie Peterson, 18, Leesburg, had been charged with murder.

Accompanying Helms and the two boys back to Leesburg are High Sheriff S. T. Alexander, Commonwealth Attorney Charles S. Harrison and Police Sergeant L. E. Thomas and Patrolman E. B. Mitchell, all of Leesburg.

The party left here in Loveless' automobile which was found at Cumberland yesterday. The two boys were arrested shortly before dawn at a hotel in Appalachia, Va.

Cumberland Patrolman Jimmy Johnson quoted the boys as admitting robbing and beating Loveless but denied knowing the capitol lawyer was dead. Johnson said both boys admitted "some shots were fired" during a scuffle.

At Leesburg, Va., Claude Honick, partner of Loveless in his agriculture interests, disclosed meanwhile that Hoback had been employed as a farm hand on the Loveless estate but said he had been discharged five weeks ago "because he was sullen and wouldn't work."

Oregon Gas Sales Zoom in October

SALEM, Nov. 28 (AP)—Gasoline sales in Oregon during October totaled 27,377,376 gallons, largest October figure in history, and a gain of 4,162,433 gallons over the same month last year.

Sales for the first 10 months of 1941 were a record high of 251,324,777 gallons, a gain of 31,102,338 gallons over the similar period of 1940. Gas tax collections during the 10 months were \$12,566,239, a gain of \$1,555,118 over the similar period last year, and more than the collections for all of 1939.

Plans Completed For Army Camp Near Albany

ALBANY, Nov. 28 (AP)—Captain T. E. Dittbrandt, construction quartermaster in charge of the Albany-Corvallis cantonment headquarters here, said last night that plans for the 40,000-acre project are practically completed, appraisals made and the way prepared for letting of contracts.

Accordingly, Captain Dittbrandt said, the contractor-architect offices will be closed December 3, though a small staff will be retained to make any necessary alterations.

John W. Cunningham, contractor-engineer, and Abbott Lawrence and F. S. Allyn, architects, Portland, and their associates will leave.

Captain Dittbrandt revealed that the cantonment plans provide for a power supply line from the Bonneville substation at Albany. He has recommended complete electrical equipment for this camp, he added, and if these recommendations are accepted the Albany cantonment will be probably the first in which electricity is used for cooking, baking and water heating as well as lighting.

Alternate plans provide facilities for either one or two army divisions.
