Portland Export. Volume Decreases PORTLAND, Dec. 4 (AP) — Portland's export volume has fallen 50 per cent from last year, estimated figures indicated today, but more valuable cargoes are being shipped.

In the 11 months of 1941 the number of foreign-trade ships calling here has declined 34 per cent from the figure in the corresponding 1940 period. Only American and Russian ships were more numerous this year than last.

Sharp declines were noted in shipment of fresh apples and canned pears and substantial increases in shipments of machinery and canned milk.
