ARCHBISHOP ASKS MASS TIME CHANGE

PORTLAND, Dec. 13 (AP)—Archbishop Edward D. Howard ordered changes in the time of masses in all Catholic churches throughout the archdiocese of Portland in Oregon Thursday to conform to blackout regulations. Portland priests were instructed not to hold masses before 8 a. m., either daily or Sunday. The time during which masses may be offered on Sunday was extended to 12:15 p. m. The late Sunday mass was subject to three restrictions: That it be a high mass; that diocesan "church music regulations" be adhered to; that a sermon be preached. Parishers outside Portland were advised
