Ham Slow to Cook: Fruit Cake Quickie for Holiday



Sants carves the Christmas bam. The Christmas festive meats are usually turkey, goose, suck-ling pig, rib roast or glazed ham. The choice is a matter of taste

and pocketbook.

BAKED CHRISTMAS HAM If a pre-cooked ham is used, follow the directions on the wrapper around the ham in bak If a smoked ham is used scrub ham with a brush. Soak 12 to 14 hours in cold water to cover. Drain. Place skin side up in open roaster. Insert meat thermometer in ham so that bulb will be in center of ham, but not touching bone. Bake in slow oven (300 degrees F.) allowing 30 minutes per pound for whole hams and 35 minutes per pound for small or half-hams, or cook until final reading on meat ther-mometer is 170 degrees F. Take ham from oven and remove skin Soak Virginia ham 12 hours in cold water to cover. Trim rusty edges and scrub with brush.
