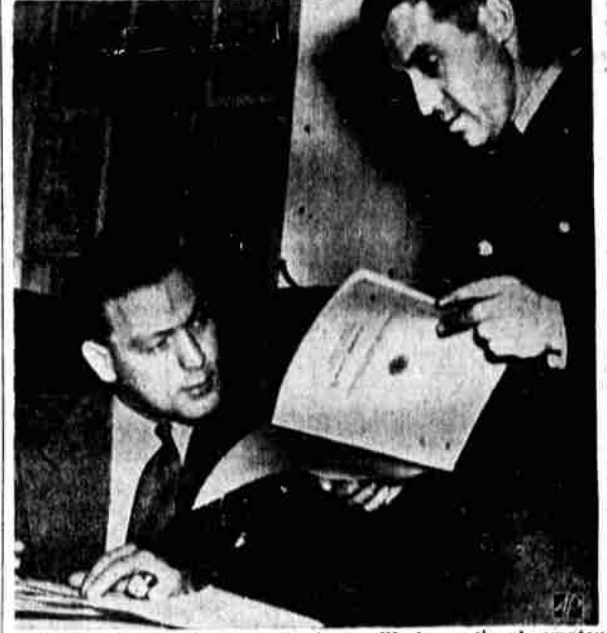
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Cleveland Named 1941 Disappointment

Railroad Earnings Rise in Oregon

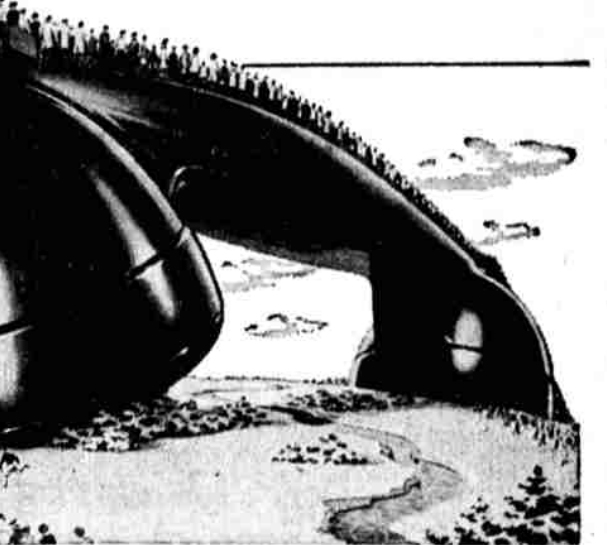
