PROFIT TAKERS STOP CLIMB OF STOCK MARKET

NEW YORK, Jan. 14 (AP) - A little profit selling today threw the stock market off the forward pace followed in the previous session.

Softness of the steels tended to put light pressure on other leaders and coppers and rubbers, favored on Tuesday, gave an indifferent performance.

Dealings were approximately 600,000 shares. Financial offices suggested the lack of followup buying could be attributed mainly to tax considerations and fears of more bad news from the Pacific. The decision of the president to name Donald M. Nelson as chief of a new war production board was pleasing to Wall street but its immediate market influence was limited by questions as to how the new setup would affect industry.
